This year, JCF established two new scholarships in the area of entrepreneurship; it also established the Chevening-Jeffrey Cheah Foundation scholarship for the 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic years pursuing a medical, physical or life sciences related Masters course at either the University of Cambridge, the University of Oxford, or Lancaster University. To promote the appreciation of arts, the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation launched the RM10 million Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali Scholarship for Creative Arts &
