It conducts short skill training courses for a duration of one month to six months. In this respect, it is one of the Authorised Test Centres for PC Competency Test, a test that gauges and evaluates a person’s skills in general PC proficiency.

The School of IT also conducts a three year degree course which includes the core units as well as a number of highly in demand subjects such as Java Programming to add value to the degree. The partners for the degree programme are National Computing Centre (NCC), UK and London Guildhall University, UK.
