



SUNWAY STUDENTS SHINE IN LEICESTER

*M*alaysians who undertook a twinning degree programme at Sunway College, Petaling Jaya, shone at the law and engineering final exams at Leicester University, England.

Ooi Huey Ling and Yeow Chun Ming are two top performers in the Law examinations that was conducted at Leicester University in the United Kingdom.

Huey Ling obtained a first class honours LLB and was given a

joint award prize of \$300 for outstanding performance in the Part Two examination while Yeow Chun Ming, who sat for his second-year examination, was awarded the Harvey Ingram and Simpson Company Law Prize worth \$500.

All the 37 law students from Sunway who sat for the Part 2 final examination passed their papers.

A group of 17 students, pioneers in the Sunway College's Western Michigan University programme, recently graduated with degrees in business administration. They were the first batch of students to transfer from the college to WMU in 1989.

Grierson prize of \$250 for best performance in industry-linked courses while W.L. Liew won the Federicks Barnes Waldren prize of \$450 for the most outstanding student in mechanical engineering.
