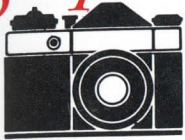

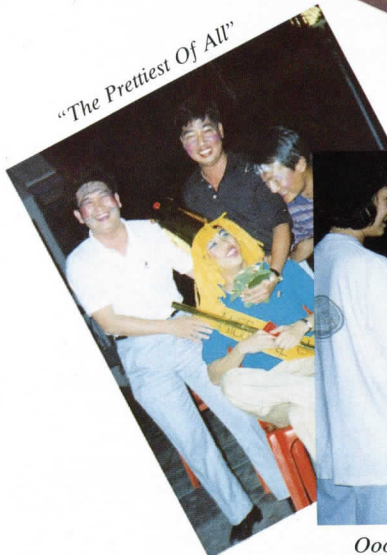

Following is the speech by our Group Managing Director, Dato' Jeffrey Cheah, during the Group Annual Dinner.

SPEECH BY GROUP MANAGING DIRECTOR

Honoured guests, my fellow colleagues, ladies and gentlemen.

Good evening and a very warm welcome to the SungeiWay Group Annual Dinner and Dance.

We are very honoured to have with us tonight our Minister of Transport and the MCA President, Yang Berhormat Dato' Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik and other distinguished guests to grace our function.

My colleagues and I wish to extend to all of you our deep appreciation for your presence here tonight to join us in celebrating this annual function of our Group.

The Malaysian economy is in its fourth consecutive year of growth,

albeit at a slower pace. Real GDP growth for 1991 is projected to be around 8.6% as compared to the growth rate of 9.8% in 1990 and 8.5% in 1989.

Recently, our Prime Minister indicated that the GDP growth for 1992 will be in the region of 8%. We Malaysians are very fortunate to be living in a country with a robust economy, a very stable Government and people of different races enjoying peace and harmony.

The buoyant domestic economic activities in the last four years have fuelled the growth of the construction sector, which is expected to remain robust for at least another year and is projected to attain another double digit growth of 13.5% this year.

This augurs well for our Group as a large percentage of our operations are in the construction, quarrying, readymix and building material sectors. In line with the conducive economic climate of the country, our Group in 1991 achieved very inspiring results on all fronts with a turnover of approximately \$800 million.

For 1992, the Group is expected to achieve a turnover in the region of \$1 billion. To all our employees in the Group, I thank you for the excellent achievement. You have done SungeiWay proud.

Up to the year just ended, our property arm, Bandar Sunway has sold a total of 2,457 units of linkhouses, industrial units, shophouses and walk-up apartments. About 80% of these units have been completed and handed over to the purchasers.

The current year will be a very busy year for Bandar Sunway. It will launch about 1,200 units of industrial units, linkhouses, semi-detached houses and condominiums. Work at the Bandar Sunway Town Centre, which covers an area of approximately 175 acres, is progressing according to schedule.

The Water Theme Park and the new College campus are expected to be completed by the third and fourth quarters of this year respectively.

The first phase of the new College campus will be operational

in December this year. It will have a build-up area about four times our present campus size and, in addition, it will have residential facility for about 1,000 students.

Construction works have commenced on the Corporate Headquarters, Recreational Clubhouse and the Amphitheatre. The Recreational Clubhouse which is situated on a 5-acre site adjacent to our Corporate Headquarters, will be completed by end of the year and Kelab Sukan Sunway can take pride to have their headquarters at the Clubhouse.

Most of the landscaping in the Town Centre should be in place by the middle of this year. The planning of the resort hotel, commercial centre and services apartments has been completed and the project is expected to take off later this year.

Recently, we were awarded a project by the Penang Development Corporation to develop a 56-acre Town Centre at Seberang Jaya, Butterworth which is adjacent to the bypass crossroad between the East-West and North-South Highways. This will be the future town centre of the region. We hope to start work on the project later this year.

The claypipe project in Klang is scheduled to be completed by end of this year and production is expected to commence by January 1993. Once completed, our factory will employ more than 250 people and will be the biggest vitrified claypipe plant in South-East Asia.

Once again, I wish to pay tribute to our dedicated, hardworking and loyal employees. They are the pillars for the success of the SungeiWay Group. I am proud of our employees and I thank them for their loyalty and contribution.

Tonight, 17 of them, who have been with the Group for more than 10 years, will be receiving their long service awards. I extend to these good people my congratulations and appreciation for their achievements and contribution.

As our Group grows bigger, becomes more diversified, complex and international, we need managers with vision, clarity of purpose and commitment to steer the course.

We must continually look into the future and ask: "What are we? What do we want to be? How are we going to get there?" Essentially

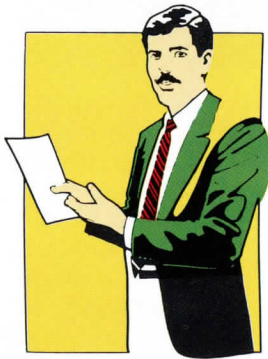

OFFICE AUTOMATION FOR SUNGEIWAY GROUP

*T*he SungeiWay Exco, senior management, PCMs (Profit Center Managers), departmental managers and some clerical staff had attended two sessions of demonstrations and presentations of the Uniplex range of integrated office automation software at Sunway Computer Services in February and March this year.

During these meetings, Sunway Computer Services presented their vision of the corporate office automation strategy to be based on the UNIPLEX software running on the IBM RISC System/6000, running the UNIPLEX application which includes an integrated word processor, spreadsheet, database and business graphics as well as the office productivity tools such as electronic mail, calendaring and time management tools.

"By using an integrated software like Uniplex, users will be able to do their work more efficiently and productively, as data from one application can be used in another without any intermediate conversion, and the problems associated with such a requirement," said Mr Melvin Mills, General Manager of SWCS.

This proposal is in line with the long term corporate strategy of moving most of the companies to the new corporate building in Bandar Sunway, as all the RISC System/6000s can then be linked together in a Local Area Network (LAN), and for those sites not in the building, in a Wide Area Network. This will facilitate intra- and inter-company communications.

SUNWAY APPOINTED AGENT FOR BIS BANKING SYSTEMS

Sunway Computer Services (SWCS) has been appointed the agent for a UK software company, BIS Banking Systems (BIS). Under the terms of the agreement signed on 5th March 1992, SWCS will provide sales and support for BIS's sophisticated "total banking" solution, Midas Advance Banking Solutions (MIDAS ABS) in Malaysia.

BIS is the world's leading supplier of international banking software, and is part of the NYNEX Corporation - one of the largest

corporations in the world. Their software solutions are already in use by more than 750 organisations throughout the world.

MIDAS ABS, which runs on the IBM AS/400 platform enables the automation of all international wholesale banking functions - from the capturing of a deal and position through to settlement and funds transfer. The software adopts a flexible and comprehensive core database which provides users with an essential foundation for sophisticated information and risk control.

SUNWAY IS THE BEST IBM PARTNER

IBM Malaysia held a dinner party in January for its seventeen business partners to thank them for making 1991 another big year for its mid-range systems. During the Go for Growth event, IBM gave away awards to several business partners for outstanding achievement.

The biggest award of the night, the Business Partner of the Year Award went to Sunway Computer Services (SWCS). The award was based on a number of criteria - customer satisfaction, revenue achievement as a percentage of assigned quota, timeliness of payment of A/R (accounts receivable), accuracy of monthly forecast and others. Sunway also won an award for being the highest revenue generator for IBM Malaysia, bringing in \$10.2 million worth of SME (small and medium enterprises) business, or 18 per cent of IBM's total SME business. 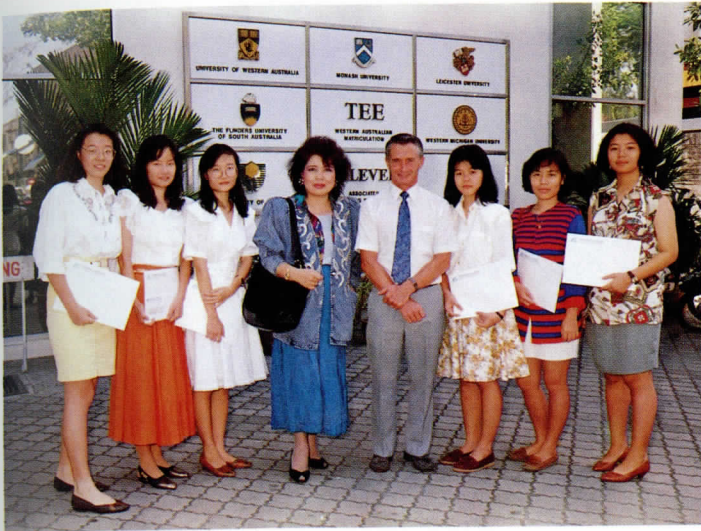

Also at the graduation ceremony were Principal of the Canadian Matriculation Programme - Dr. Rex Sharman, Sungei Way's EXCO members, the Management staff of

Sunway College, Mr. Kaspar Pold - Director of Education Canada, invited guests, students, parents and staff of the Canadian Matriculation Programme.

SUN-BLOCK UPGRADES ITS FACILITIES

Paving the way for the next generation

Sun-Block Sdn Bhd, a member of The Sungei Way Group, has set itself for another stage of rapid growth. The company has over the past few months, upgraded the production and handling lines of its existing plant at Sg Rasa, Kelang. As a result, there is now a 30% increase in the production capacity from its Zenith block and paver machine. In addition, the company has also just commissioned a Schlosser machine, adjacent to the existing plant, to boost up its overall production volume. The combined output from these two machines has now doubled compared with the single machine before upgrading.

The company was previously known as Sungei Way Kurata Industries Sdn Bhd, set up way back in 1983. In 1985, it was changed to the present name of Sun-Block Sdn Bhd, with a complete re-organisation of its set up. A sophisticated plant from the German manufacturer, Zenith Maschinenfabrik GmbH Neunkirchen was then purchased and installed to manufacture Interlocking Concrete Paving Blocks (ICPB) in addition to Concrete Masonry Units (CMU) which it previously made. The company then embarked on an aggressive strategy to promote the usage of its products to the Malaysian market. Backed by the vast resources of its parent company, Sun-Block scored a number of 'firsts' in the market. We saw the introduction of 'double process' ICPB, palletising and crane truck delivery system, adaptation of the latest international standards, use of computer software in design and many others.

In order to better serve its customers, Sun-Block has now installed a TOLL FREE line (No. 8003363) in the Sales Office in Kelang. A permanent showroom, displaying the complete range of its products, is now under construction and will be ready in April. By then, potential customers can make use of these facilities to assist them in making an ideal decision in their purchases.

Alur Setar jadi bandar pertama guna jalan bata

ALUR SETAR — Bandar Alur Setar dijangka menjadi bandar pertama di negeri ini menggunakan jalan simen (bata) secara lebih meluas jika percubaan awal penggunaan jalan tersebut mencapai kejayaan.

Jalan berteknologi baru itu atau nama saintifiknya *interlocking concrete paver* sekarang dibina di simpang Lebuhraya Darulaman berhadapan dengan Balai Seni Negeri sebagai satu percubaan untuk melihat sejauh mana kekokohan dan ketahanan.

Jurucakap Jabatan Kerja Raya (JKR) negeri berkata hasil kajian yang dibuat mendapati jalan tersebut boleh menyerap lelehan

minyak daripada kenderaan - kenderaan berat serta tahan antara lima hingga tujuh tahun berbanding dengan jalan tar biasa.

Katanya, kajian juga mendapati jalan *interlocking concrete paver* sesuai digunakan di atas tanah yang lembut, tidak mudah pecah, boleh menyerap air hujan, tidak bertakung minyak, tidak licin walaupun musim hujan dan sebagainya.

Menurutnya, jika pembinaan jalan tersebut yang panjangnya kira-kira 40 meter dan berharga \$11,000 itu sesuai untuk kenderaan - kenderaan ringan dan berat JKR akan membina secara meluas.

"Ia adalah kerana keadaan tanah di Alur Setar begitu lembut dan penggunaan jalan tar biasa sudah tentu tidak tahan lama, jadi adalah sesuai diubah dengan menggunakan jalan si-

men," ujarnya. Beliau berkata, *interlocking concrete paver* sengaja dibina di simpang kerana kebanyakan kenderaan akan berhenti seketika di hadapan lampu isyarat dan keadaan itu membolehkan pihaknya melihat sejauh mana ketahanan dan kekokohan jalan itu.

Mampu

Jurucakap itu menjelaskan, percubaan awal juga mendapati jalan tar yang biasa digunakan hanya mampu bertahan antara satu hingga dua tahun sahaja, cepat melusap apabila ditakung minyak dan tidak mudah menyerap air berbanding dengan jalan teknologi baru itu.

Bagaimanapun, terangnya, terserah kepada pengguna - pengguna jalan raya sama ada sesuai dengan jalan baru itu

atau tidak kerana kedua-dua jenis jalan itu mempunyai kelebihan dan kekurangannya.

Menurutnya lagi, jika pembinaan *interlocking concrete paver* mencapai kejayaan yang diharapkan usaha meluaskan lagi pembinaannya dilakukan secara berperingkat dan ditumpukan di simpang - simpang jalan. "Kita kena tengok dulu tempat-tempat yang sesuai dan jika perlu JKR akan memajukan projek ini atau mungkin di seluruh Bandar Alur Setar dalam usaha mengekalkan ketahanan dan keselamatan bandar ini," katanya.

Beliau menambah, pada masa ini belum ada cadangan untuk menambah atau memajukan jalan baru itu sehingga percubaan awal di simpang itu melihat keputusan yang positif.

Sun-Block Sdn Bhd is not just geared to provide dependable supply. The company can also provide the necessary technical input in project design including any specialised construction details, project implementation and even maintenance. For paving jobs in particular, it has the expertise and experience to take on installations, especially in demanding situations.

Despite having the present range of strong, versatile and attractive products, the company is continually looking into newer product features to suit the changing needs of end-users. An ongoing process of research and development is carried out for this purpose. Besides, a painstaking quality control procedure is established at every stage of the production process,

from raw material selection right through to pre-packing checks, to ensure that every Sun-Block product conforms to the required specifications.

In terms of usage of ICPB, new ideas developed overseas are being introduced to the local market. When ICPB was first sold in the early 80's, they were mainly used for architectural and landscape purposes. Today, heavy-duty engineering applications constitute a significant proportion of their demand, due to their high structural strength and excellent load spreading capabilities. Almost all the major oil companies use ICPB for their service station forecourts. The first container yard using ICPB was installed by Sun-Block in 1987 and the product is now considered the

ideal choice for container pavement. The success has prompted the use for other heavy-duty works such as pavement for warehouses, industrial hardstands, roads, lorry parking areas and others which demand high strength and abrasion properties. The latest usage is for pavement on steep gradients, bridge decks, road intersections and airport parking aprons. In this respect, innovative ideas for new areas of usage are continually being explored to widen the overall market size.

As for CMU, there is now a growing emphasis among users on the need for quality, away from the traditional backyard products. In addition, there is greater appreciation of its thermal and acoustic properties. Due to the lower deadweight for blocks and ease of handling in palletised form, its immense potential has now been tapped for use in highrise construction. The above factors have enhanced its overall acceptability, even for use in medium to high cost dwelling units.

Besides ICPB and CMU, Sun-Block also makes a range of

attractive and colourful decorative CMU, ideal for external and internal walls where aesthetics take equal importance to its functional ability. The products include long split bricks, corduroy blocks, half-height split and unsplit blocks in various colours. These can be used for garden walls, planter boxes, external and internal feature walls, etc.

Over the years, Sun-Block has a long list of completed projects, including many large and prominent ones. As both TCPB and CMU have been considered to have entered the growth stage of their product life cycle (PLC), their future market potential remains good. The construction of expanded infrastructure facilities, particularly for roads, container yards/ports, airports and tourism-related projects, will result in greater demands for ICPB. The construction of a large number of highrise buildings and residential houses in the Klang Valley will create a greater demand for more CMU.

Due to the above, Sun-Block's management is seriously evaluating the feasibility of setting up a new

plant in the Klang Valley and locating one plant each in the North and South of the Peninsula. For a start, sales offices are being set up in Penang and Johore Bahru and potential customers can now choose to call either the respective regional offices or the head office for any product requirements.
