One of the ways to meet this challenge is of course to plan for the future. Emphasis on literacy and numeracy as foundation blocks should remain along

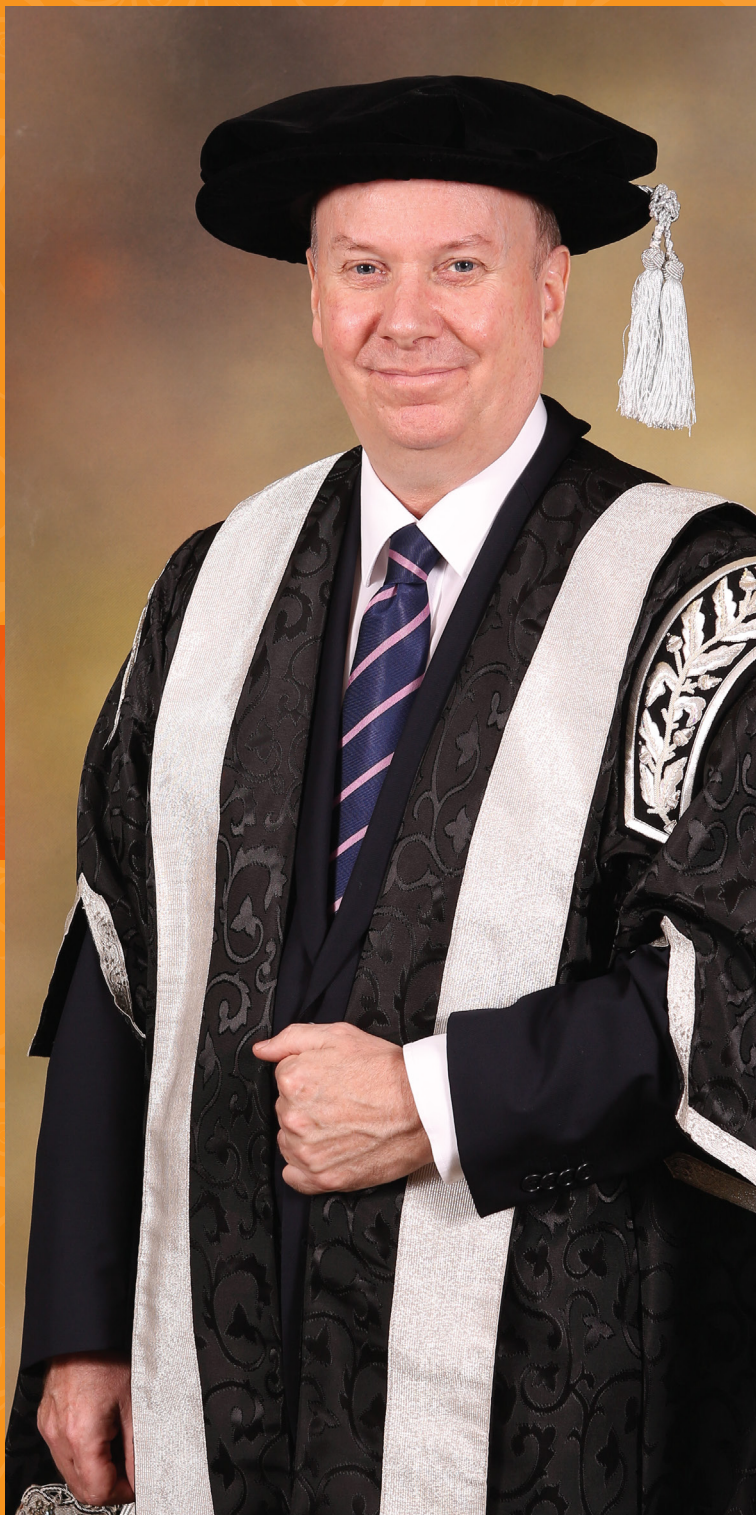

The Graduation Ceremony

The formal conferring of university degrees goes back to medieval times in Europe, when scrolls, signifying their achievements, were granted to the graduates with great pomp and ceremony, reinforcing their rank, privileges and responsibilities in a highly stratified society. Graduation ceremonies were very rowdy affairs, however, exemplified by the lowering of a large wooden spoon, from the balcony in the Senate House in Cambridge, to the graduate who came bottom of the class in the Mathematics Tripos.

Nowadays such behaviour is frowned upon and the ceremonies have the dignity which befits the occasion. Special ceremonial robes are worn signifying, in the case of degrees, status as a bachelor, master or doctor, and the hoods, derived from medieval dress, signify the discipline or institution of the degree. A sash rather than a hood, worn over a black gown, signifies a diploma.



Academic Dress

The academic dress adopted by the universities of the Commonwealth follows the style of Oxford or Cambridge. Sunway University has adopted the Oxford style which, for bachelor and master degrees, a black gown and hood lined with satin, are worn with a mortar board. The design of the hood helps distinguish between bachelor and master. The hoods for both bachelor and master use the colours of the University; cyan blue, vivid orange and authentic grey.



The same colours are used in signifying diplomas but, instead of a hood, a sash is worn.

The PhD gown with bell-shaped sleeves is in bright orange with blue and grey trimmings, representing the colours of the University. The front trimming of the gown is embellished with the University's Coat of Arms and the gown is worn with a soft-crowned round-brimmed bonnet.



The Coat of Arms

Responsibility for the granting of Coats of Arms has rested with the College of Arms in London since AD1484. Applicants are considered by the Garter King of Arms, and if he deems the individual, family or organisation to be worthy of this distinction then the Arms are duly granted. Registers are maintained to ensure that new designs are unique and that existing designs are protected.

In 2005, the Board of Sunway University (formerly Sunway University College) resolved to seek Arms from the College of Arms, and in May 2006, a grant of Arms to Sunway was approved.

The main elements of a Coat of Arms are the crest and the shield. Mottoes do not form a part of a grant of arms, but most grantees choose a succinct statement which represents individual or organisational statements of purpose or values.

The Sunway University *shield* contains three geometric shapes known as “piles”, each “charged” with a golden sun. Together, the piles form a “W” and, with the suns, the device suggests the name Sunway. The stylized suns have a slight resemblance to the star on a blue background that appears on the Malaysian flag.

The *crest* is more obviously symbolic of Malaysia, consisting, as it does, of a Malaysian tiger. It is shown holding a torch, often used in heraldry to symbolize learning and teaching.

Our motto “*Fortuna Eruditae Favet*” derives from Louis Pasteur’s famous phrase “*la chance ne sourit qu’aux esprits bien préparés*”. Pasteur, commenting in 1855 on Oersted’s “chance” discovery of electromagnetism, expressed the view that chance discoveries take place only in the context of a prepared mind. We have adapted the phrase to read “Fortune Favours the Prepared Mind” and this was translated into Latin by Professor Thomas N Mitchell, Provost and Professor of Latin at Trinity College Dublin.

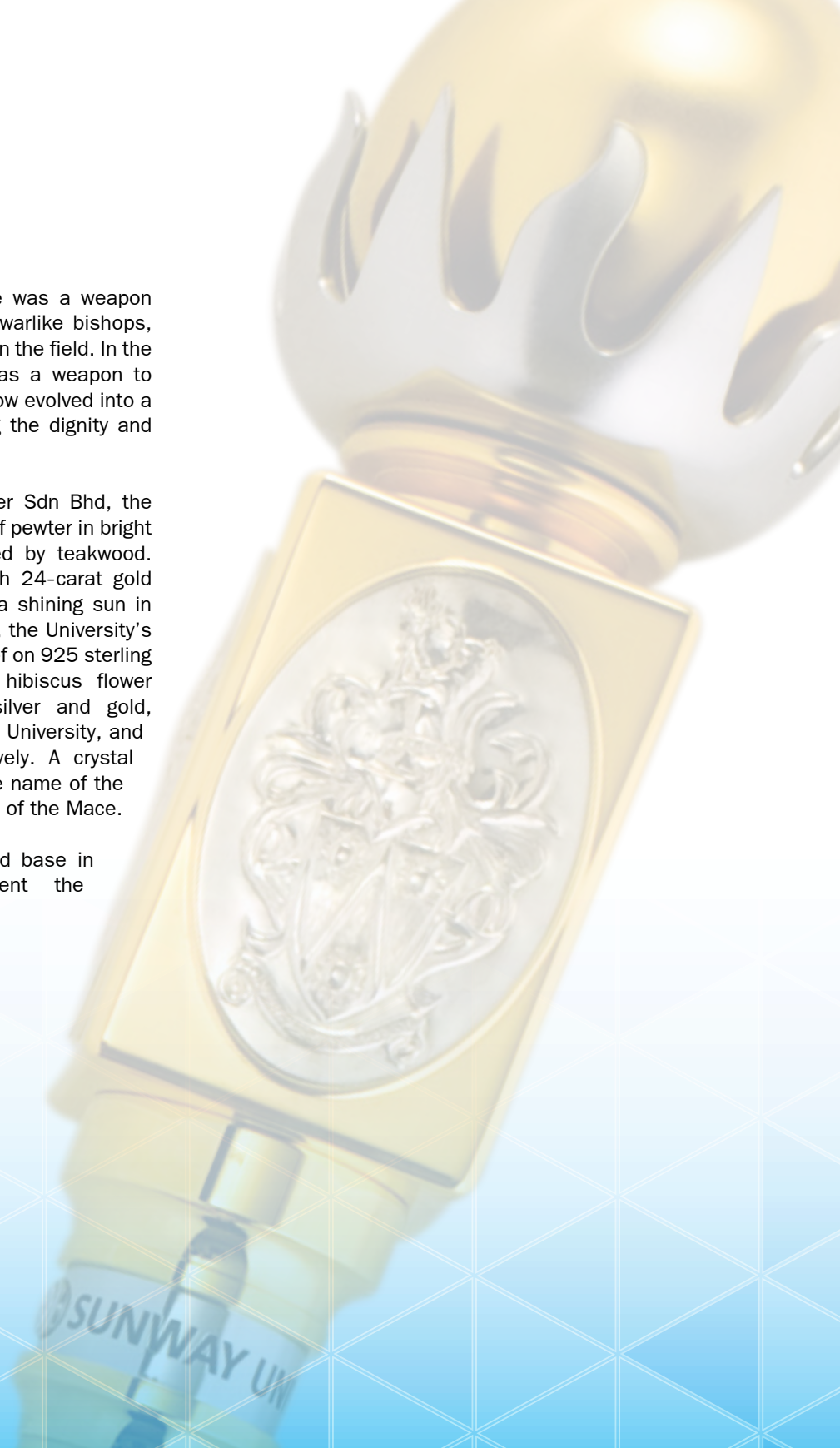


The Mace

In the medieval Europe, the mace was a weapon carried into battle by knights and warlike bishops, reflecting their status and prowess in the field. In the university context, it was carried as a weapon to protect the Chancellor, but it has now evolved into a purely ceremonial device signifying the dignity and authority of the Chancellor.

Designed by Royal Selangor Pewter Sdn Bhd, the Mace is 4.5ft in length. It is made of pewter in bright finish and its interior is supported by teakwood. Relevant parts are highlighted with 24-carat gold plating. The head of the Mace is a shining sun in gold plate and, directly underneath, the University's Coat of Arms is hand chased in relief on 925 sterling silver. The progressive "S" and hibiscus flower motifs, also hand chased on silver and gold, represent the parentage of Sunway University, and the identity of Malaysia respectively. A crystal stone is set at the beginning of the name of the institution to mark the front section of the Mace.

The Mace rests on a nyatoh wood base in mahogany finish to complement the Chancellor's Chair.





The Chancellor's Chair

The Chancellor's Chair is made of solid nyatoh wood, and finished in satin mahogany lacquer. The seat, backrest and armrests are wrapped with natural rich brown leather from Germany.

The Coat of Arms of the University, in a highly sculptured relief on a finely textured background, and cast in pewter with gold plating, is placed at the apex of the backrest. The apex itself is modelled on the upper part of the portico of the then Sunway University building.

The Chancellor's Desk

The Chancellor's Desk is mostly hand-built with the same Malaysian top hardwood, nyatoh to complement the Chancellor's Chair. With the selected design, the timber was machine-cut beading, and hand polished and vanished in mahogany lacquer. The decorative gold motifs around the Desk are computer numerical control cut from the solid timber and finished with gold coat. The Desk is 175cm in length by 75cm in depth and 75cm in height.

The University continues its quest to achieve World class standards, and through being owned by the non-profit Jeffrey Cheah Foundation is able to maximize the utilization of its financial resources for the benefit of the education provided and the student experience, which sets it apart from many other institutions in Malaysia.

Many graduates today receive dual certificates from both Sunway University and Lancaster University which has been a close collaborator of Sunway since 2006. Lancaster is consistently ranked as one of the top 10 universities in the UK. Some graduates will today receive certificates of professional recognition from Le Cordon Bleu, a well-known international culinary education provider, demonstrating the international quality of the hospitality programmes.

The University campus is effectively a global community with over 11% of the total student body coming from overseas with over 60 countries represented. The University prides itself on offering high quality support both to Malaysian students and to our international students and congratulates all of today's graduates on their achievement.



Jeffrey Cheah Foundation

Nurturing the Seeds of Wisdom



The Jeffrey Cheah Foundation ('JCF') is founded on the fundamental premise of giving to society, a philosophy that has governed the Sunway Education Trust Fund since its inception in 1997. As a not-for-profit Foundation, operating surpluses are reinvested in the institutions for expansion of faculty and facilities, and disbursed as scholarships and research grants, ensuring that education and development programmes of the highest quality are supported and sustained.

As a result of its well-thought-out corporate structure and status as a registered charity, the Foundation is able to continue in perpetuity Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah AO, its Founding Trustee's vision and legacy of giving. At the same time, it also serves as a catalyst and as a vehicle for others to contribute to the shared cause of education.

Governed by a distinguished Board of Trustees, the Foundation aims to safeguard the institutions under its care for the purpose of providing education at the highest level, including knowledge transfer to those from disadvantaged backgrounds. To date, the Foundation has allocated in excess of RM330 million (as of October 2017) worth of scholarships and counting, to thousands of deserving students in various fields of study in Malaysia and overseas including the Universities of Cambridge, Harvard and Oxford.

Cheah Travel Grants following a generous gift by the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation. In conjunction with the contribution, the Jeffrey Cheah Institute on Southeast Asia (JCI) has been set up at Sunway University to facilitate and support education exchange opportunities between Sunway Education Group and Harvard University.

In 2014 and 2015, historic agreements were signed with the University of Cambridge and the University of Oxford, England. With benefaction by the JCF, the agreements led to the appointment of two Jeffrey Cheah Professorial Fellows respectively in Gonville & Caius College, University of Cambridge, and Brasenose College, University of Oxford.

In April 2016, the JCF gifted USD10 million to the United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) establishing a strategic collaboration in setting up the Jeffrey Sachs Center on Sustainable Development at Sunway University. The pioneering Center offers some of the world's best curriculum, academic and executive programmes on sustainable development. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah AO believes this is an important step in the right direction, to develop the global expertise needed to move Malaysia and Asia forward in the area of sustainable development.

In November 2017, the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation and Sunway Medical Centre signed several agreements

with the University of Cambridge that mark the 800-year-old world-renowned university's first such entry into Asia, and the first collaboration of its kind in the world. As part of the collaboration, Sunway Medical Centre will establish the Sunway Clinical Research Centre, which will be a Regional Site Partner of the University of Cambridge School of Clinical Medicine. The agreements include the establishment of a joint programme between the University of Cambridge School of Clinical Medicine, the Royal Papworth Hospital, Sunway Medical Centre, Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences, and Sunway University. The programme will enable the sharing of academic excellence through regular academic visits and exchanges, and offer scientific and clinical training opportunities at Cambridge for outstanding postgraduates from Sunway.

The Jeffrey Cheah Foundation currently owns and governs 16 educational institutions and entities of the Sunway Education Group that includes Sunway University, Sunway College, Monash University Malaysia, Sunway International School and the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences. JCF is today the largest education-focused social enterprise in Malaysia and continues to seek ways to advance the academic standards in Malaysia through collaborative partnerships with top ranking universities.

Early in 2005, Sunway and Lancaster University in the UK commenced discussions on how the two institutions might co-operate, during these discussions the concept of dual degrees was explored. Lancaster conducted an institutional review in March 2006, which involved a site visit by senior academics from the University and a senior academic from the University of Sussex. This resulted in the signing of an affiliation agreement between the two institutions. The agreement provides for the validation of relevant Sunway degrees by the Senate of Lancaster University following site visits by course consultants and lengthy panel discussions by video conference. Sunway University students who successfully complete an honours degree programme are now awarded both Sunway and Lancaster degrees, with separate scrolls from each institution.

Lancaster University has been named University of the Year by The Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide 2018, and is ranked in the Top 10 of all three major UK league tables – The Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide 2018 (6th), the Complete University Guide 2019 (8th), and the Guardian University Guide 2019 (9th). As well as being highly placed for student satisfaction, employment and research.

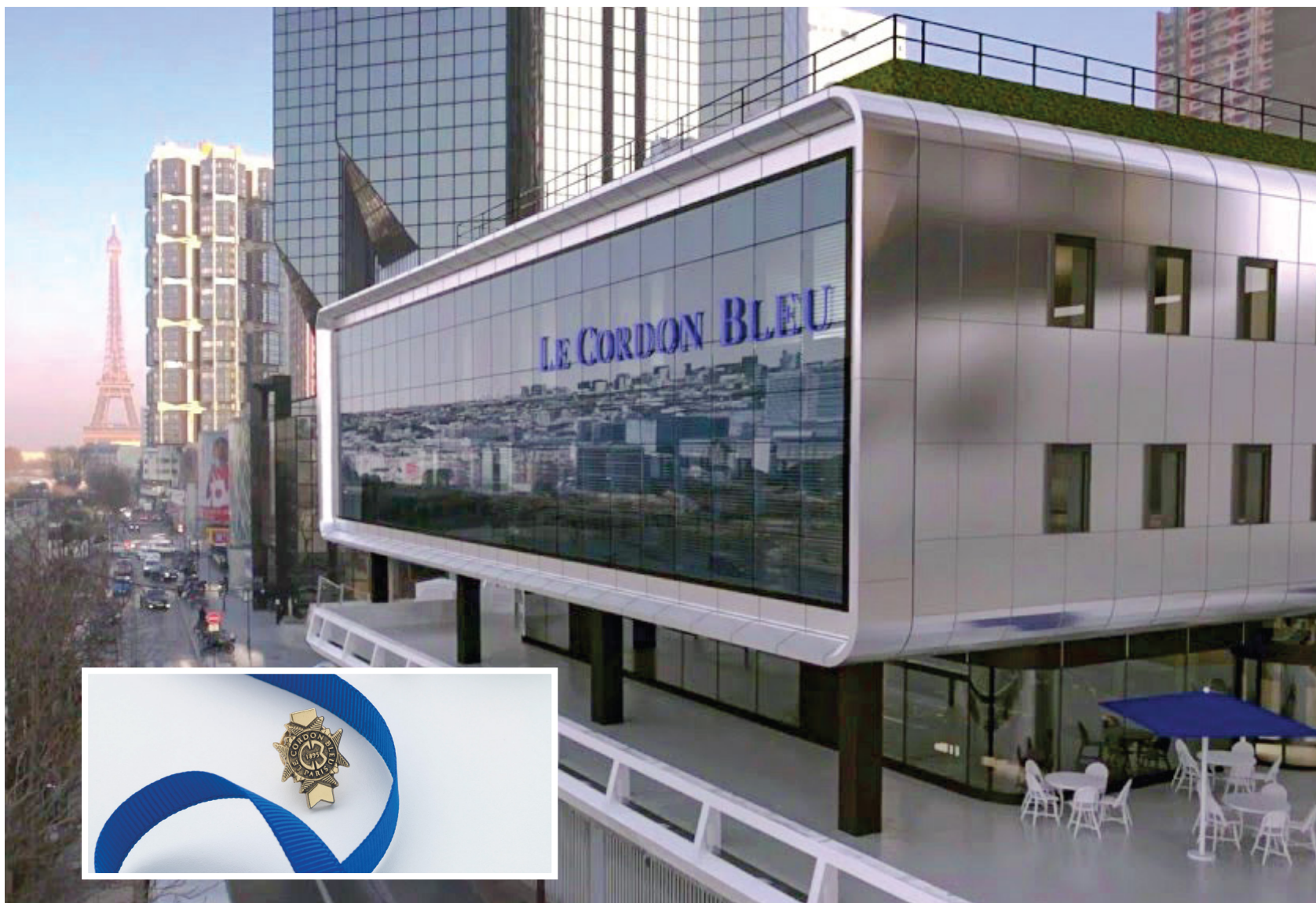
A highly ranked global university, 83% of Lancaster's

research is internationally excellent and world-leading, measured by the 2014 Research Excellence Framework which assesses the quality and impact of research. Lancaster rose four places to 131st out of 1,011 universities in the QS World University Rankings 2019 and has also been awarded the Gold Standard in the UK's Teaching Excellence Framework.

91% of students at Lancaster University are satisfied overall (NSS 2017) and the University is frequently singled out for its high levels of graduate employment; 97% of graduates are in either employment or further study three and a half years after graduating (Destinations of Leavers from Higher Education Longitudinal Survey, 2017).
