2018 Malaysian Jazz Workshop

The Sunway University School of Arts and ASWARA, the National Academy of Arts Culture and Heritage, will jointly host the 2018 Malaysian Jazz Workshop from 26-28 October. The workshop will be a partnership with Jazz Education Abroad, an international organization of jazz educators dedicated to teaching jazz outside the USA. This three-day workshop is designed for jazz students age 13 through adult, at any level of competency. The master teachers for the workshop will include international educators together with local Americans and Malaysians. The workshop leader is Prof. Gene Aitken, long-time Director of Jazz Studies at the University of Northern Colorado and a Grammy-nominated Fulbright Scholar who is considered one of the most exciting and energetic jazz educators/clinicians today. Recognised as a visionary in jazz education, music education, and computer technology, Prof. Aitken was inducted into the International Jazz Educators Hall of Fame in 1995 along with Doc Severinsen and Ella Fitzgerald.

Students in this workshop will participate in big bands, small combos, improvisation classes, instrumental master classes, and faculty performances. All students from middle school and above (including adults) are welcome - no previous jazz experience is required.
