


are testimony to our sense of purpose in improving lives and creating a brighter future. It's why we motivate our students to "Live, Learn, and Lead."



The Graduation Ceremony

The formal conferring of university degrees goes back to medieval times in Europe, when scrolls. signifying their achievements, were granted to the graduates with great pomp and ceremony, reinforcing their rank, privileges and responsibilities in a highly stratified society. Graduation ceremonies were very rowdy affairs, however, exemplified by the lowering of a large wooden spoon, from the balcony in the Senate House in Cambridge, to the graduate who came bottom of the class in the Mathematics Tripos.

Nowadays such behaviour is frowned upon and the ceremonies have the dignity which befits the occasion. Special ceremonial robes are worn signifying, in the case of degrees, status as a bachelor, master or doctor, and the hoods, derived from medieval dress, signify the discipline or institution of the degree. A sash rather than a hood, worn over a black gown, signifies a diploma.



Academic Dress

The academic dress adopted by the universities of the Commonwealth follows the style of Oxford or Cambridge. Sunway University has adopted the Oxford style which, for bachelor and master degrees, a black gown and hood lined with satin, are worn with a mortar board. The design of the hood helps distinguish between bachelor and master. The hoods for both bachelor and master use the colours of the University; cyan blue, vivid orange and authentic grey.



The same colours are used in signifying diplomas but, instead of a hood, a sash is worn.

The PhD gown with bell-shaped sleeves is in bright orange with blue and grey trimmings, representing the colours of the University. The front trimming of the gown is embellished with the University's Coat of Arms and the gown is worn with a soft-crowned round-brimmed bonnet.



The Coat of Arms

Responsibility for the granting of Coats of Arms has rested with the College of Arms in London since AD1484. Applicants are considered by the Garter King of Arms, and if he deems the individual, family or organisation to be worthy of this distinction then the Arms are duly granted. Registers are maintained to ensure that new designs are unique and that existing designs are protected.

In 2005, the Board of Sunway University (formerly Sunway University College) resolved to seek Arms from the College of Arms, and in May 2006, a grant of Arms to Sunway was approved.

The main elements of a Coat of Arms are the crest and the shield. Mottoes do not form a part of a grant of arms, but most grantees choose a succinct statement which represents individual or organisational statements of purpose or values.

The Sunway University shield contains three geometric shapes known as "piles", each "charged" with a golden sun. Together, the piles form a "W" and, with the suns, the device suggests the name Sunway. The stylized suns have a slight resemblance to the star on a blue background that appears on the Malaysian flag.

The *crest* is more obviously symbolic of Malaysia, consisting, as it does, of a Malaysian tiger. It is shown holding a torch, often used in heraldry to symbolize learning and teaching.

Our motto "Fortuna Eruditis Favet" derives from Louis Pasteur's famous phrase "la chance ne sourit qu'aux esprits bien preparés". Pasteur, commenting in 1855 on Oersted's "chance" discovery of electromagnetism, expressed the view that chance discoveries take place only in the context of a prepared mind. We have adapted the phrase to read "Fortune Favours the Prepared Mind" and this was translated into Latin by Professor Thomas N Mitchell, Provost and Professor of Latin at Trinity College Dublin.



The Mace

In the medieval Europe, the mace was a weapon carried into battle by knights and warlike bishops, reflecting their status and prowess in the field. In the university context, it was carried as a weapon to protect the Chancellor, but it has now evolved into a purely ceremonial device signifying the dignity and authority of the Chancellor.

Designed by Royal Selangor Pewter Sdn Bhd, the Mace is 4.5ft in length. It is made of pewter in bright finish and its interior is supported by teakwood. Relevant parts are highlighted with 24-carat gold plating. The head of the Mace is a shining sun in gold plate and, directly underneath, the University's Coat of Arms is hand chased in relief on 925 sterling silver. The progressive "S" and hibiscus flower motifs, also hand chased on silver and gold, represent the parentage of Sunway University, and the identity of Malaysia respectively. A crystal stone is set at the beginning of the name of the institution to mark the front section of the Mace.

The Mace rests on a nyatoh wood base in mahogany finish to complement the Chancellor's Chair.

The Chancellor's Chair is made of solid nyatoh wood, and finished in satin mahogany lacquer. The seat, backrest and armrests are wrapped with natural rich brown leather from Germany.

The Coat of Arms of the University, in a highly sculptured relief on a finely textured background, and cast in pewter with gold plating, is placed at the apex of the backrest. The apex itself is modelled on the upper part of the portico of the then Sunway University building.

The Chancellor's Desk

The Chancellor's Desk is mostly hand-built with the same Malaysian top hardwood, nyatoh to complement the Chancellor's Chair. With the selected design, the timber was machine-cut beading, and hand polished and vanished in mahogany lacquer. The decorative gold motifs around the Desk are computer numerical control cut from the solid timber and finished with gold coat. The Desk is 175cm in length by 75cm in depth and 75cm in height.







Sunway University is one of the nation's leading private universities. With over 7,500 students studying on more than 60 academic programmes across disciplines in the arts, sciences, business, finance, mathematical sciences, healthcare and hospitality, Sunway is a broad-based high quality institution delivering higher education that equips graduates for the 21st century work environment.

Consistently providing high quality education, Sunway University has achieved five-star "excellent" ratings in the official Ministry of Education "SETARA" rating system for Malaysian universities and university colleges since 2007. The University is ranked in the top 2% of universities in the Asia University Ranking by the international ranking and rating organisation "QS". Additionally Sunway University was ranked globally for the first time by the QS World Rankings 2020. With this ranking, the University also managed to secure a place within the top 150 young universities in the world. The University also has a five-star overall international rating from QS and was the first private non-government linked university in Malaysia to reach this high standard.

The University continues its quest to achieve World class standards, and through being owned by the non-for-profit Jeffrey Cheah Foundation is able to maximize the use of its financial resources for supporting leading edge research, as well as for offering scholarships to talented students who would not otherwise be able to afford a good university education.

The University has strong international links and the campus is effectively a global community with over 13% of the total student body coming from overseas with over 60 countries represented. The University offers dual degrees with Lancaster University, which is ranked in the top 10 in the UK. There are also collaborations on research, scholarship and entrepreneurship development with Harvard University, the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, and the University of California, Berkeley. These collaborations include visiting scholar programmes, joint research projects and co-organised conferences.



Jeffrey Cheah Foundation

Nurturing the Seeds of Wisdom



The Jeffrey Cheah Foundation (JCF) is founded on the fundamental premise of giving to society, a philosophy that has governed its predecessor, the Sunway Education Trust since its inception in 1997. Through the Foundation, operating surpluses are ploughed back into the 16 institutions of the Sunway Education Group for expansion of faculty and facilities, and disbursement of scholarships and research grants, ensuring that education and development plans of the highest quality are supported and sustainable.

As a result of its well-thought-out corporate structure and status as a registered charity organisation, the Foundation is able to continue Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah AO, its Founding Trustee's vision and legacy of giving in perpetuity. In fact, the latest accolade for Tan Sri Dr Jeffrey Cheah AO is the naming after him of a magnificent new building in the Cambridge Biomedical Campus, which will be the largest biomedical cluster in Europe when it is completed. Called the 'Jeffrey Cheah Biomedical Centre (JCBC)' the building is situated in a precinct on the Biomedical Campus that contains the world famous MRC Laboratory of Molecular Biology, which

has produced 16 Nobel Prizes, the Li Ka Shing/CRUK Cancer Research Centre, the leading Royal Papworth Hospital, and the Astra Zeneca World Research Centre.

The JCF also serves as a catalyst and platform for others to contribute to the shared cause of education. Governed by the distinguished Board of Trustees, JCF aims to safeguard the institutions under its care for the purpose of providing education at the highest level, including knowledge transfer to those from disadvantaged backgrounds. Up till October 2018, the Foundation has awarded in excess of RM402 million worth of scholarships to thousands of deserving students in various fields of study in Malaysia and overseas including at the University of Cambridge, Harvard University and University of Oxford. This year, another RM65 million has been set aside for scholarships and study grants.

In 2013, JCF and Harvard University signed agreements to establish at Harvard, two Jeffrey Cheah Professorships on Southeast Asia Studies following a generous gift by the JCF to Harvard. In conjunction with the gift, the Jeffrey Cheah Institute



on Southeast Asia (JCI) has been set up at Sunway University to facilitate and support education exchange opportunities between the staff of Sunway Education Group and Harvard University.

Historic agreements were signed with the University of Cambridge and the University of Oxford in 2014 and 2015 respectively. With benefactions by the JCF, the agreements led to the appointment, in perpetuity, of two Jeffrey Cheah Professorial Fellows each at the Gonville & Caius College, University of Cambridge, and Brasenose College, University of Oxford. A Scholar in Residence programme was also instituted which allows for two Sunway Education Group academics to reside in Brasenose for four weeks each year, in perpetuity, to engage in research and scholarly study.

In April 2016, the JCF pledged USD10 million to the United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) establishing a strategic collaboration and the setting up of the Jeffrey Sachs Center on Sustainable Development at Sunway University.

The JCF and Sunway Medical Centre signed several agreements with the University of Cambridge in November 2017. These marked the 800-year-old world-renowned University's first such entry into Asia and the first collaboration of its kind in the world. As part of the collaboration, Sunway Medical Centre in partnership with Sunway University has established the Sunway Clinical Research Centre, a Regional Site Partner of the University of Cambridge School of Clinical Medicine.

In August last year, the University of Oxford established the Oxford-Jeffrey Cheah Graduate Scholarship, in perpetuity, with a benefaction from JCF, as well as major contributions by the University of Oxford and Brasenose College, to provide opportunities for highly talented Malaysians to further their DPhil studies in the University of Oxford.

In September 2018, an Agreement was signed by JCF with



Gonville and Caius College, University of Cambridge to establish, in perpetuity, the Jeffrey Cheah Scholars-in-Residence programme at Caius, which is similar to the previously established programme in Brasenose.

In March 2019, JCF signed a Memorandum of Understanding with British High Commission to fund the Chevening–Jeffrey Cheah Foundation scholars from Malaysia for the 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic years to pursue a medical, physical or life sciences related master's course at either the University of Cambridge, the University of Oxford or Lancaster University.

The JCF currently owns and governs 16 educational institutions of the Sunway Education Group that includes Sunway University, Sunway colleges, Monash University Malaysia, Sunway International schools, and the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences. JCF is today the largest education-focused social enterprise in Malaysia and continues to seek ways to advance the academic standards in Malaysia through collaborative partnerships with top ranking universities.


Early in 2005, Sunway and Lancaster University in the UK commenced discussions on how the two institutions might co-operate, during these discussions the concept of dual degrees was explored. Lancaster conducted an institutional review in March 2006, which involved a site visit by senior academics from the University and a senior academic from the University of Sussex. This resulted in the signing of an affiliation agreement between the two institutions. The agreement provides for the validation of relevant Sunway degrees by the Senate of Lancaster University following site visits by course consultants and lengthy panel discussions by video conference. Sunway University students who successfully complete an honours degree programme are now awarded both Sunway and Lancaster degrees, with separate scrolls from each institution.

Lancaster University was named University of the Year 2018 by The Times and The Sunday Times Good University Guide 2018. The growing reputation of Lancaster is reflected by high rankings year-on-year in each of the UK's major university league tables – the Guardian 2020 (7th), the Complete University Guide 2020 (7th), and The Times/Sunday Times 2019 (6th). Lancaster is ranked 128th in the QS World University Rankings 2020, and 146th in the THE (Times Higher Education) World University Rankings 2019. Lancaster University was ranked 66th in the THE Best Universities in Europe 2019, placing the institution among Europe's elite universities. Lancaster University has also been ranked 3rd in the UK for

graduate-level employment in the Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide 2019, with 89% of Lancaster students going into professional work or further education after graduation.

Lancaster University has been awarded Gold in the Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF) 2017. The TEF assessed three areas – the quality of teaching; the learning environment; and, student outcomes and learning gain – with Gold requiring evidence of outstanding provision in all three. The Gold award reflects Lancaster's success in offering their students a first class experience and underlines the institution's distinctiveness in the UK. In addition, The 2019 National Student Survey revealed that 87% of Lancaster University students are satisfied overall.

At Sunway University, which has the power to award its own degrees, it is important to be able to satisfy ourselves, our students, and their parents, that the degree programmes that we offer are of the highest international standard. We are pleased that we have been able to satisfy the very stringent criteria that have been set by Lancaster University in its institutional review and the validation of our degrees. We continue to look forward to delivering our degree programmes in the knowledge that they have been validated by a world class British university in accordance with its own quality assurance protocols and those of the UK Quality Assurance Agency.
