

I believe such a ranking can only be achieved because we strive to nurture students who are not only book smart, but students who are


ready to be responsible citizens of our country and the world. We aim to educate citizens who will contribute to society and, hopefully, you too will not forget to contribute to your alma mater.

The formal conferring of university degrees goes back to medieval times in Europe, when scrolls, signifying their achievements, were granted to the graduates with great pomp and ceremony, reinforcing their rank, privileges and responsibilities in a highly stratified society. Graduation ceremonies were very rowdy affairs, however, exemplified by the lowering of a large wooden spoon, from the balcony in the Senate House in Cambridge, to the graduate who came bottom of the class in the Mathematics Tripos.

Nowadays such behaviour is frowned upon and the ceremonies have the dignity which befits the occasion. Special ceremonial robes are worn signifying, in the case of degrees, status as a bachelor, master or doctor, and the hoods, derived from medieval dress, signify the discipline or disciplinary group of the degree. A sash rather than a hood, worn over a black gown, signifies a diploma.



ACADEMIC DRESS

The academic dress adopted by universities of the Commonwealth follows the style of Oxford or Cambridge. Sunway University has adopted the Oxford style which, for bachelors, has a black gown and hood, the hood being lined with satin. The design of the hood helps to distinguish between bachelor and masters but it is the colour of the lining of the hood that signifies the discipline group.

The following colours are used to represent degrees in the respective faculties in Sunway:

- **Faculty of Arts** Navy Blue
- **Faculty of Science and Technology** Spring Green
- **Sunway University Business School** Royal Fuchsia

The same colours are used in signifying diplomas but, instead of a hood, a sash is worn.

The doctorate gown with slit-cut above the elbow sleeves is in bright orange with blue and grey trimmings, representing the colours of the University. The front trimming of the gown is embellished with the University's Coat of Arms and it is worn with a soft-crowned round-brimmed bonnet.

Honorary Doctorate Recipient

Y.Bhg. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Utama Arshad Ayub

The award of the Doctor of Education *Honoris Causa* (EdD Sunway hc):
For contributions to the development of, and access to, Malaysian higher education



Tan Sri Dato' Seri Utama Arshad Ayub was born in Muar, Johor, in 1928. He is the eldest child in a rubber tapper family and in his early years experienced much hardship and poverty. He suffered from typhoid and malaria and after the death of his parents, had to take responsibility for raising his four younger siblings. These early experiences gave him the determination to overcome his disadvantages through education and in later life to help others do the same.

He studied at the University Malaya, Singapore 1949 – 1951. He graduated from the College of Agriculture in Serdang and was then awarded a Colonial Development and Welfare scholarship to study at what is now Aberystwyth University in the UK where he graduated in Economics and Statistics in 1958. Subsequently, he obtained a Diploma in Business Administration 1963-1964 from the Management Development Institute, Lausanne, Switzerland (now IMD, one of the World's premier business schools).

Tan Sri Arshad joined the Malaysian Civil Service (MCS) in July 1958. Tan Sri Arshad's involvement in education began in 1965 as the Principal of the MARA College of Business and Professional Studies, which under his leadership eventually became Institut Teknologi MARA (now UiTM), one of the most successful education institutions in the country. He made UiTM the first Malaysian institution to embrace both twinning programmes with overseas universities in particular Ohio University in Athens, USA and external UK programmes in law and professional accounting, such as the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), Chartered Institute of Transport, Chartered Insurance Institute programmes and the well-respected Bachelor of Law external degree from the University of London. Under his leadership UiTM grew from just 200 students in 1965 to almost 7000 students when he left ten years later. It is no exaggeration to say that Tan Sri Arshad is widely regarded as a far-sighted educator who has had a tremendous impact on education in Malaysia for nearly half a century.

Following his time at UiTM, Tan Sri Arshad steadily climbed the ladder of the Malaysia Civil Service to reach the rank of Secretary General of three Ministries by the time he retired in 1983. Today, Tan Sri Arshad continues to serve the nation. He is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors of University Malaya, Chancellor of KPJ International University College Of Nursing & Health Sciences and INTI International University, and Pro-Chancellor of University Technology Mara (UiTM). He serves as Chairman and Director of several public listed companies. He also sits on the Board of several non-profit and voluntary organisations.

For his immense achievements in higher education and the civil service and for improving the lives of so many people through his efforts in creating educational opportunities for thousands of deserving students, today Sunway University is proud to award its first ever Honorary Doctorate to Tan Sri Dato' Seri Utama Arshad Ayub.

Responsibility for the granting of Coats of Arms has rested with the College of Arms in London since AD1484. Applicants are considered by the Garter King of Arms, and if he deems the individual, family or organisation to be worthy of this distinction then the Arms are duly granted. Registers are maintained to ensure that new designs are unique and that existing designs are protected.

In 2005, the Board of Sunway University (formerly Sunway University College) resolved to seek Arms from the College of Arms, and in May 2006, a grant of Arms to Sunway was approved.

The main elements of a Coat of Arms are the crest and the shield. Mottoes do not form a part of a grant of arms, but most grantees choose a succinct statement which represents individual or organizational statements of purpose or values.

The Sunway University *shield* contains three geometric shapes known as “piles”, each “charged” with a golden sun. Together, the piles form a “W” and, with the suns, the device suggests the name Sunway. The stylized suns have a slight resemblance to the star on a blue background that appears on the Malaysian flag.

The *crest* is more obviously symbolic of Malaysia, consisting, as it does, of a Malaysian tiger. It is shown holding a torch, often used in heraldry to symbolize learning and teaching.

Our motto “*Fortuna Eruditus Favet*” derives from Louis Pasteur’s famous phrase “*la chance ne sourit qu’aux esprits bien préparés*”. Pasteur, commenting in 1855 on Oersted’s “chance” discovery of electromagnetism, expressed the view that chance discoveries take place only in the context of a prepared mind. We have adapted the phrase to read “Fortune Favours the Prepared Mind” and this was translated into Latin by Professor Thomas N Mitchell, Provost and Professor of Latin at Trinity College Dublin.

In the medieval Europe, the mace was a weapon carried into battle by knights and warlike bishops, reflecting their status and prowess in the field. In the university context, it was carried as a weapon to protect the Chancellor, but it has now evolved into a purely ceremonial device signifying the dignity and authority of the Chancellor.

Designed by Royal Selangor Pewter Sdn Bhd, the Mace is 4.5ft in length. It is made of pewter in bright finish and its interior is supported by teakwood. Relevant parts are highlighted with 24-carat gold plating. The head of the Mace is a shining sun in gold plate and, directly underneath, the University's Coat of Arms is hand chased in relief on 925 sterling silver. The progressive "S" and hibiscus flower motifs, also hand chased on silver and gold, represent the parentage of Sunway University, and the identity of Malaysia respectively. A crystal stone is set at the beginning of the name of the institution to mark the front section of the Mace.

The Mace rests on a nyatoh wood base in mahogany finish to complement the Chancellor's Chair.



THE MACE

The Chancellor's Chair is made of solid nyatoh wood, and finished in satin mahogany lacquer. The seat, backrest and armrests are wrapped with natural rich brown leather from Germany.

The Coat of Arms of the University, in a highly sculptured relief on a finely textured background, and cast in pewter with gold plating, is placed at the apex of the backrest. The apex itself is modelled on the upper part of the portico of the then Sunway University building.



Sunway University has its origins in Sunway College, founded by Y. Bhg. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah, AO, in 1986 to provide opportunities for young Malaysians to obtain higher education and training at the certificate, diploma and degree levels, especially in areas of national need. The first intake of students in 1987 numbered about 200, enrolled in degree studies leading to bachelor degrees from a number of foreign universities. These courses were delivered through the 'twinning' arrangements, pioneered by Sunway College, whereby students spent one or two years in Sunway and then transferred to the foreign university to complete their degrees. Degree programmes of Western Michigan University (WMU) in the US were the first to be introduced and these were followed by twinning arrangements with a number of UK and Australian universities. In the late 1990s, 3+0 degree programmes were approved by the Malaysian Government and Sunway College was able to offer the business degrees of Victoria University, Australia, entirely in Malaysia while continuing the 2+2 programmes with WMU.

In addition, the Malaysian Government sanctioned the establishment of branch campuses of foreign universities and Sunway again took the initiative. In a historic agreement with Monash University, Australia, the first branch campus of a foreign university was established at the Sunway campus in 1998. In July 2007, Monash University Sunway campus moved to a magnificent new campus at Jalan Lagoon Selatan, Bandar Sunway. It is currently offering a full range of undergraduate degrees, including medicine through its Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences, which was established in 2005.

In 2004, Sunway College was elevated to the status of a University College, by the then Minister of Higher Education YB Dato' Dr Shafie Mohd Salleh, with the power to grant degrees. With foresight, this was immediately followed by discussions with a top international university to further value-add to the degrees offered at Sunway University College. In 2006, a UK-based university and ranked in the top 1% of universities in the world, Lancaster University, officially sealed a partnership agreement with Sunway to validate relevant Sunway degrees.

After consistently providing high quality standard education, Sunway received its university upgrade in December 2010. The courses leading to degrees at Sunway University are approved by the Ministry of Higher Education and the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA). The University has been achieving Excellent ratings in the official rating system of all universities and university colleges in Malaysia, the SETARA 2009, SETARA 2011 and SETARA 2013 by the MQA. Sunway University was officially registered in January 2011 and came into being with the vision of becoming a world-class university.

When Sunway University achieved its full university status, its popular twinning, Pre-University and professional accounting programmes were transferred to a new Sunway College therefore allowing the University to focus on its own diploma, undergraduate and postgraduate curricula.

Sunway University currently has a student population of over 5,000. It is a veritable global community on campus as around 20% of its total student number is international, coming from over 90 countries. Sunway University has just moved to a brand new purpose-built state-of-the-art building.



The fundamental premise of the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation (JCF) is giving to society, a philosophy that has governed its predecessor, the former Sunway Education Trust Fund since its inception in 1997.

With the advent of this new special purpose nonprofit vehicle, 12 education institutions making up the Sunway Education Group were transferred to the Foundation including Sunway University, Sunway Colleges, Monash University Malaysia, Sunway International School and the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences, making the JCF, perhaps the largest social enterprise in Malaysia.

As a result of its deliberately planned corporate structure and status as a registered charity, the Foundation is able to continue in perpetuity. Y. Bhg. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah's vision and legacy of giving; while at the same time serving as a catalyst and as a vehicle for others to contribute to the shared cause of education.

Whether through the Trust Fund, or now the Foundation, operating surpluses are ploughed back into the academic institutions or disbursed as scholarships and research grants, ensuring that education of the highest quality is supported and sustained.

Governed by a distinguished Board of Trustees, the Foundation aims to safeguard the institutions under its care for the purpose of providing excellent and affordable education at the highest level, including education for those that come from disadvantaged backgrounds. There is thus a means, through scholarships, for the present and future generations of deserving students to succeed. To date, more than RM210 million in scholarships have been awarded to over 23,000 Malaysian students in various fields of study in Malaysia and overseas such as the Universities of Cambridge and Oxford.

In 2013, the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation and Harvard University signed agreements to establish at Harvard, two Jeffrey Cheah Professorships on Southeast Asia Studies i.e. the Jeffrey Cheah Professor and the Jeffrey Cheah Visiting Professor; and the Jeffrey Cheah Travel Grants following a generous gift by the Jeffrey Cheah Foundation. In conjunction with the contribution, the Jeffrey Cheah Institute on Southeast Asia (JCI) has been set-up at Sunway University to facilitate and support education opportunities between Sunway Education Group and Harvard University.

In November 2014, a historic agreement was signed in Cambridge. With a benefaction by the JCF, the agreement led to the appointment of two Jeffrey Cheah Professorial Fellows in Gonville & Caius College, University of Cambridge.

The Sunway Education Group's unique structure is a first-of-its-kind in Malaysia for private education institutions, and modelled after the structure of some of the oldest and most eminent universities in the world, one being Harvard University.



Lancaster University



Early in 2005, Sunway and Lancaster University in the UK commenced discussions on how the two institutions might co-operate and, in the course of these discussions, which extended over one year, the concept of dual degrees was explored. Lancaster conducted an institutional review in March 2006, which involved a site visit by senior academics from the University and a senior academic from the University of Sussex. As a result, in September 2006, Lancaster approved the signing of an affiliation agreement between the two institutions. The agreement provides for the validation of relevant Sunway degrees by the Senate of Lancaster University following site visits by course consultants and lengthy panel discussions by video conference. Sunway University students who successfully complete an honours degree course are now awarded both Sunway and Lancaster degrees, with separate scrolls from each institution.



Lancaster University, founded in 1964, is one of Britain's best research and teaching universities. It has confirmed its place among the world's elite institutions with its consistent high placing in all major league tables.

Lancaster has won international recognition for the quality of teaching and research, with 83% of research recognised as being world-leading or internationally significant and 91% of Lancaster students saying they are satisfied with their course. Lancaster graduates can be sure of a successful start in their career, with 97% of graduates getting a job or further study place within 6 months of graduation.

In Sunway University, which has the power to award its own degrees, it is important to be able to satisfy ourselves, our students, and their parents, that the

degree courses that we offer are of the highest international standard. We are pleased that we have been able to satisfy the very stringent criteria that have been set by Lancaster University in its institutional review and the validation of our degrees. We continue to look forward to delivering our degree programmes in the knowledge that they have been validated by a world class British university in accordance with its own quality assurance protocols and those of the UK Quality Assurance Agency.
