Aside from taking a break from coding, the session also fostered team-working spirit and a sense of belonging among the Cadets. Many came out of their shells and found friends with common interests.

# Examination Rank 02

After our campus had reopened, some of our Cadets had also taken a 3-hour long examination that will allow them to move up in their levels.

The exam was held on campus on the 28th of October 2021, and also considered a trial run for us to test out the process in a physical setting, since the core programme had been conducted virtually for quite some time.

Now that our physical campus had reopened, we are looking ahead and will plan to hold examinations more frequently - twice a month, for Cadets to level up as and when they are ready.



# 42KL Cadets **Top 3** in CodeathonX 2021

Some of our Cadets have participated in the **CodeathonX 2021**, a flagship tech talent accelerator programme organised by Code for Asia, with the aim to nurture and boost people aged 18-35 in creating change using technology. 2 participating teams consisted of Cadets and Pisciners from 42KL - **Team GreenHero** and **Team Six Sense**, and both teams had secured places in the top 3!

Not only that our 42KL Cadets have gained outstanding achievements in this hackathon by proposing innovative tech solutions that align with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, but we are also extremely proud to see how the 42 way of a peer-to-peer learning extended beyond the Piscine and the Core Programme.

Despite not being selected to join the Core Programme, some of our past Pisciners of 42KL had joined our Cadets to form Team GreenHero. It is even more wonderful to see such strong teamwork which allowed them to achieve 3rd place in the hackathon, although they have never met each other in person!



## **Team GreenHero - 2nd runner-ups in CodeathonX 2021**

*Team GreenHero consists of 2 Cadets and 2 past Pisciners of 42KL. The quartet came up with a solution of creating a mobile app which incentivise recycling and to raise awareness among the older Malaysian population.*

It was also amazing to see our 42KL Cadets getting out of their comfort zones and being more confident in taking the lead in this hackathon.

One of our Cadets had demonstrated not only her leadership skills, but also her ability to work well with other teammates from other non-coding fields. Team Six Sense ultimately achieved 2nd place for their innovative solution for the gig economy which is ever-expanding.

It is also interesting to highlight that out of the 5 Cadets and Pisciners, 4 of them are our female coders! We are extremely proud of what they have achieved, and will continue our commitment in providing equal opportunities for all here at 42KL.



## ***Team Six Sense - Runner-ups in CodeathonX 2021***

*Team Six Sense was led by a 42KL Cadet who worked with four young talents in other fields - Accounting, Dentistry, Event Management, and Maritime Tech. The team proposed a mobile app for gig economy workers which includes elements of gamification that differentiated itself from other job search apps.*

Aside from 42KL, the Sunway FutureX building is host to SunwayX Farms, where you will be given a tour of as well!

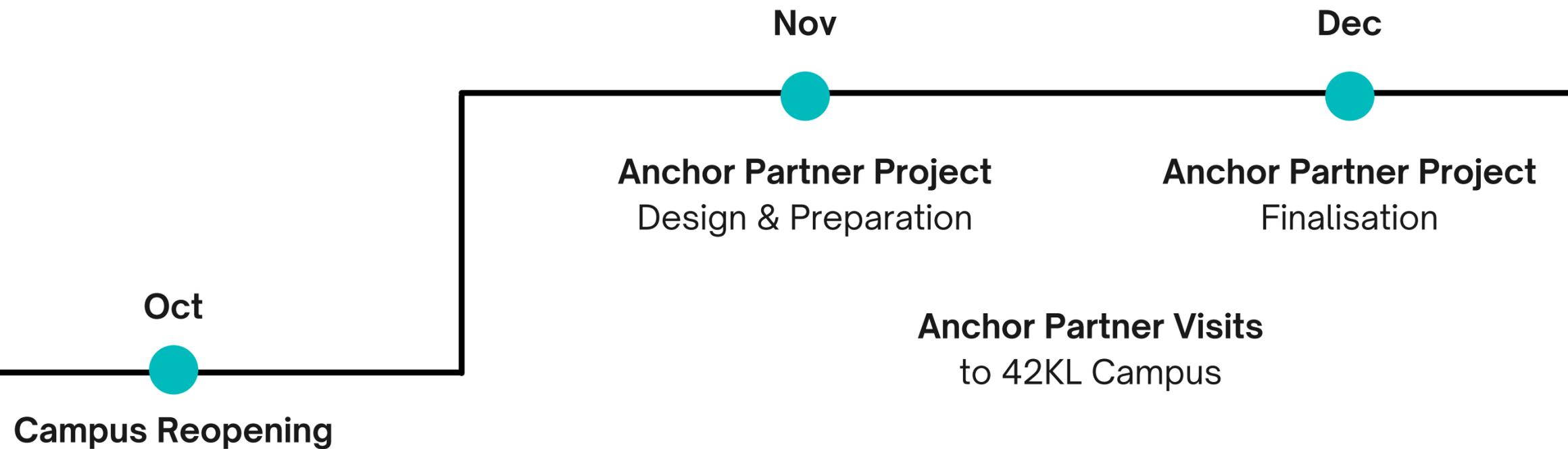
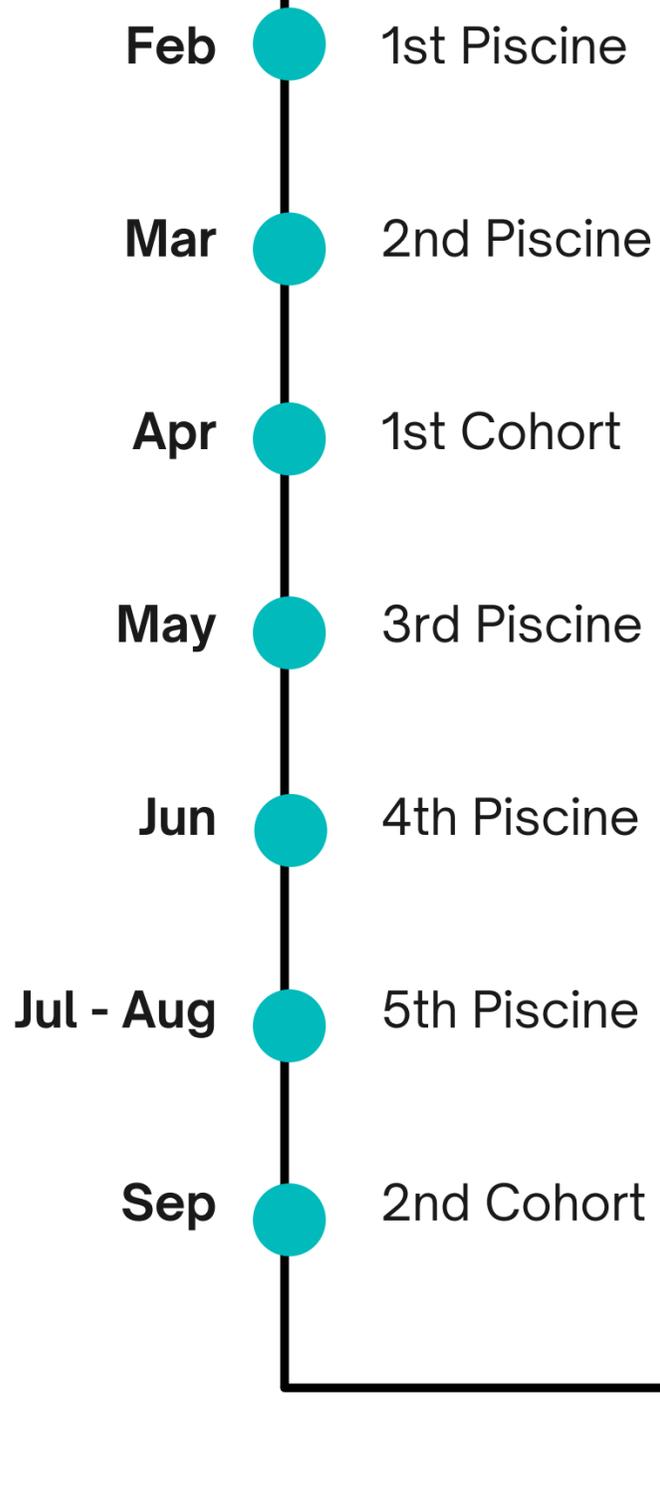
