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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



Hello SIS Community.

It has been a busy term and there has been much happening over the past months so this is one of my longer SIS Matters messages.

After such a long duration of online classes, limited classroom experiences, no field trips or other activities, we seem to be turning the corner and resuming many of the activities that make SIS such a special place for students. Just a few weeks ago, we resumed our face-to-face ECAs and the student/staff response was fantastic. To me, SIS has always been a place that radiated a special energy long after classes ended at 3:20pm. Walking the halls again, and seeing students in leadership activities like Student Council and Green Team or going to the SIS Hall and seeing the recent Sports Carnival or just a group of students and teachers playing badminton is something very special.

As we look forward to the July – December semester, we hope to resume competitive sports against other schools. And let's not forget how these changes have already affected classes. Students can openly engage in group work and are already back working on their collaboration and presentation skills. When I speak to prospective parents, I always emphasize these 21st century learning skills that are just as important as the content our teachers are teaching to the students.

In my most recent e-mail communication to the SIS Community, I mentioned that we must keep in mind that we are still living with Covid-19 present in our lives and around us, and we continue to prioritise the safety of students and staff. However, for those students who can return to classes face-to-face, they continue to benefit more than those students online and the longer one remains away from school, the harder the adjustment will be when we resume full face to face classes in January 2023 as we anticipate doing so.

I want to also inform the entire SIS community that in March 2022 we underwent our annual inspection from the Ontario Ministry of Education and passed with flying colors. I think the importance of the annual inspection is sometimes overlooked. As the only licensed provider of Canadian education in Malaysia, this is a very important assurance of the quality of instruction and assessment that every SIS child gets. While other international schools have no annual inspections from external ministries, we're proud that every year we excel in this very important activity and look forward to continued success.

Finally, I want to send a sincere thank you to all the teachers who have worked through this challenging time of hybrid teaching. This semester has been far more challenging than fulltime face-to-face or fulltime online instruction and their efforts have been instrumental to the success of our students.

From The Desk



DEPUTY PRINCIPAL Michael Owen michaelo@sunway.edu.my Recently, we observed the two-year anniversary of the first reports of COVID, the first MCO, and the first lockdown here in Malaysia. The impacts of COVID have been wide and deep in all aspects of our lives. Here at SIS, we continue to weather the challenges and changes brought about by this unprecedented global phenomenon. Throughout it all, our community has remained resilient and we continued to work together as best as we could to make the most of the access and resources we have available.

The January 2022 school year had one of the best starts to a school term under COVID. We had an incredibly high response to face-to-face learning with the vast majority of our students physically present in the classrooms. On average, there were 1 to 3 students logging into these classes virtually and hybrid learning continued as it had in previous semesters. The overall energy was very high and SIS began to feel like it had prior to the first lockdowns. Unfortunately, this enjoyment was short-lived as the Omicron variant impacted Selangor severely with Subang and Petaling Jaya seeing a very large increase in daily cases in February. During this time, SIS had its first reported case of a student with COVID and our Response Team was activated for the first time. After some adjustment as policies were put into practice, I am proud to say that with the combined efforts of our SIS Nurse, Ms. Yash; our Operations Coordinator, Mr. Keong; and the SIS Administration Office, we have been handling the cases effectively and with ever growing efficiency. SIS has the advantage of being a part of the Sunway Education Group's Health and Safety Department and we receive further support from SEG when responding to cases and maintaining safe and clean environments.

It is unfortunate that the current rise in cases continue to impact SIS to the time of writing but there are other

developments that encourage a further return to normal school operations. On Friday, 18 March, the Ministry of Education released new guidelines that allow face-to-face athletics, ECAs, and CCAs to resume operations. This is exciting and after two long years, provides excellent opportunities to lead, collaborate, build community, and simply burn off excess energy! By the time this article is published, our updated ECA list will be communicated to our students and parents and our MPH, the FIFA field and pool will see a welcome increase in usage. Our social, academic, artistic, and community-based clubs will also be found using our classrooms after school hours once again. I am also receiving a significant number of student proposals for clubs, activities, fundraising, and charity events. All of these aspects of what makes a school more than the sum of its parts are returning to SIS piece by piece. I look forward to the next newsletter and I hope that with it, I have more good news regarding school operations.

Academic Office Updates

It was a pleasure to see so many students back on SIS campus for in-person classes in January 2022. The Omicron wave saw a return of hybrid classes in more courses, but our teachers and students continue to demonstrate resilience and flexibility in their approaches to teaching and learning during this time. With the recent welcome news that schools are once again allowed to offer in-person extracurricular activities, I look forward to seeing more students engaged in sports, arts, and events for charitable causes during the second half of the semester.

Interim Communications and Midterm Report Cards

Throughout March teachers have been communicating with parents/guardians of students who have demonstrated early signs of not being successful in their courses this semester. All students received a copy of their midterm report card through their iMail accounts on 28 March with Parent-Teacher Interviews following on 31 March and 1 April 2022. I hope these conversations were productive and will continue for the remainder of the semester to see greater chances of student success.

School Letter Award

Each semester, graduating students of SIS may be eligible for the School Letter Award. This award is one of the most prestigious awards attainable by a student since it recognises those students who have contributed positively to the community of the school through participation, leadership, and striving to be the best one can be in various aspects of school life, including the pursuit of academic excellence, athletics, co-curricular activities, and community service.

Upon completion of SIS Grade 10, students have 2 choices of programmes: they can study Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) courses or they can study International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) classes. The focus of IBDP is to help students develop the knowledge, work habits and study habits necessary to excel in university and future careers. It's a challenging programme, but it's also an effective programme: American, Australian and British universities have found that IBDP students are more likely to excel in university than students from other programmes. Our 2021 IBDP graduating class received their final marks in early January, and every year our results get better and better. 100% of our IBDP students earned their diploma, and every student finished above the world average. IBDP students earn a score out of 45; 1 our students earned a 44 and 3 of our students finished with a score above 39, placing them in the top 20% of students worldwide.
