The ABE is a unique programme providing a non-specialist general education to both practising and aspiring managers and executives. Fresh school-leavers can enter at the certificate level and make their way up to the Advanced Diploma in Business Administration going through Level 1 and 2. All levels are externally assessed except for the certificate level which is assessed internally.

This course can eventually be routed to MBA after two years of study and five years of working experience. Students may also articulate to do a degree overseas for the final nine months as the strong business foundation of the ABE programme allows them to easily adapt to the degree programmes offered by universities.

Sunway College Professional Courses Division also offers the LCCI Group Diplomas and Certificates which are widely recognised by employers, professional bodies and government agencies. The group diplomas awarded are for majors in Advertising, Marketing, Public Relations or Selling and Sales Management.
