



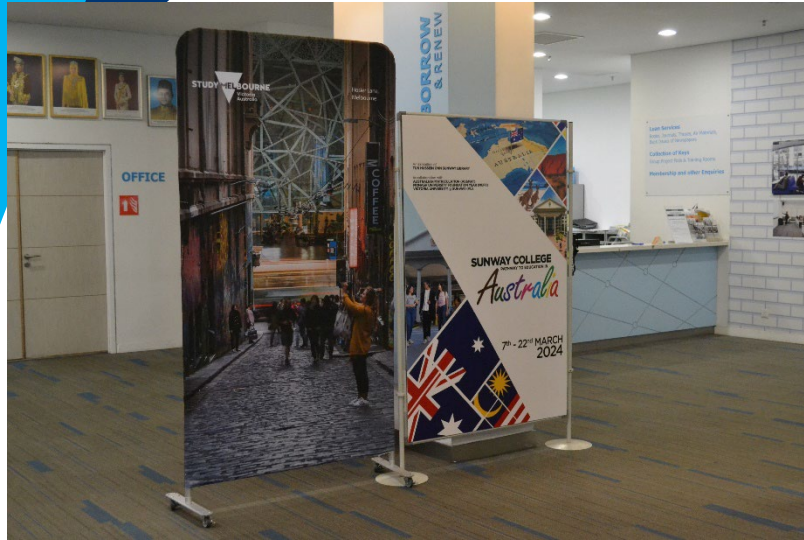

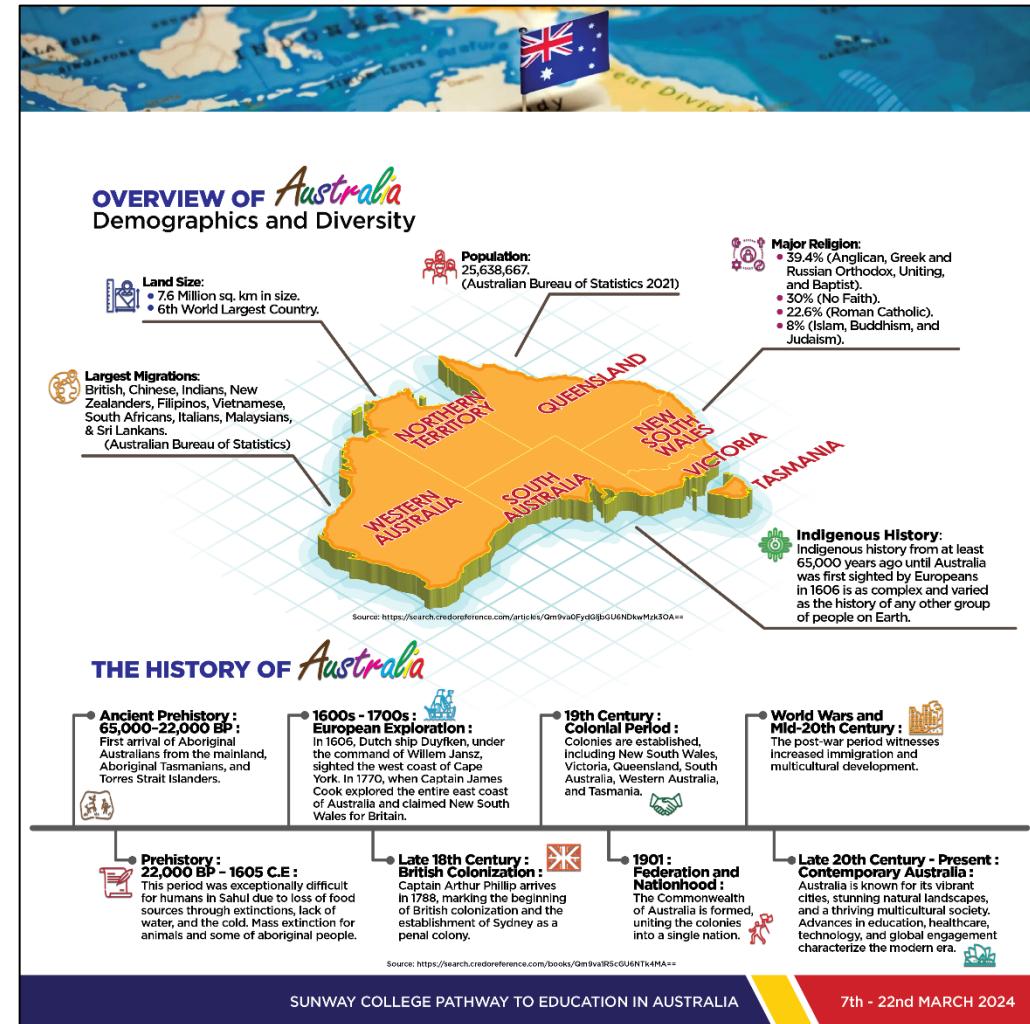

Australia INSIGHTS:

WHAT MAKES AUSTRALIA SPECIAL

- + A DIVERSE POPULATION**
Renowned as one of the world's most multicultural nations, Australia was home to 75 million migrants in 2021. That means that nearly 30% of the country's population was born overseas!
- + LAND OF WINE**
There are 65 wine regions across Australia, which produce over one billion litres of wine each year. Fun fact: South Australia contributes nearly half of that amount!
- + BEACHES GALORE**
With 10,000+ beaches stretching over 50,000 km of coastline, it would take you 29 years to visit each one if you visited one new beach every day!
- + MEET SOME FURRY FRIENDS**
Two-thirds of the world's marsupials (that is, kangaroos, koalas, wombats and others), live right here in Australia!
- + A COASTAL COUNTRY**
Because central Australia is mostly desert, 85% of the population lives within 50 km of the coast. This proximity is ideal if you love the sea breeze and beach trips.
- + OLDEST CIVILISATION**
Known as the world's oldest civilisation and Australia's first inhabitants, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples have occupied mainland Australia for at least 65,000 years.

WORLD HOME

Australia is home to the world's largest living structure, the Great Barrier Reef, which stretches over 2,300 kilometers and is teeming with diverse marine life, including over 1,500 species of fish!

HOME FOR VENOMOUS REPTILE

Australia is the habitat of the world's most venomous creatures, including the deadly box jellyfish, stonefish, and various species of snakes and spiders.

GOLD RUSH

Gold Rush in the 1850s led to a massive influx of immigrants, with over 600,000 people arriving in Australia, helping to shape the nation's economy and culture during this pivotal period (National Museum Australia)

LAND OF MARSUPIALS SPECIES

Australia is known as the "Land of Marsupials". It's the only continent where over 330 different marsupial species, such as kangaroos, wallabies, and koalas, are found.

TASMANIAN DEVIL

Australia is home to the iconic Tasmanian devil, a carnivorous marsupial known for its fierce disposition, and with a population decline of approximately 80% in the past two decades.

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE

Sydney Opera House, an iconic architectural marvel, is a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the most recognizable buildings globally.

UNIQUE MAMMAL

Platypus is a unique Australian mammal which lays eggs and is one of only five species of monotremes in the world.

RARE MARINE LIFE

Australia's oceans are home to unique and fascinating marine life, such as the dugong, a herbivorous marine mammal often called the "sea cow," and the endangered sea lion, with only around 14,000 remaining in the wild.

DRIEST EARTH

Australia is the driest inhabited continent on Earth, with vast arid regions and deserts, including the famous Simpson Desert and the Outback.
