The 15th SEA Games saw Sungei Wayans and Sunway College students involved in selling tickets and organising the event.

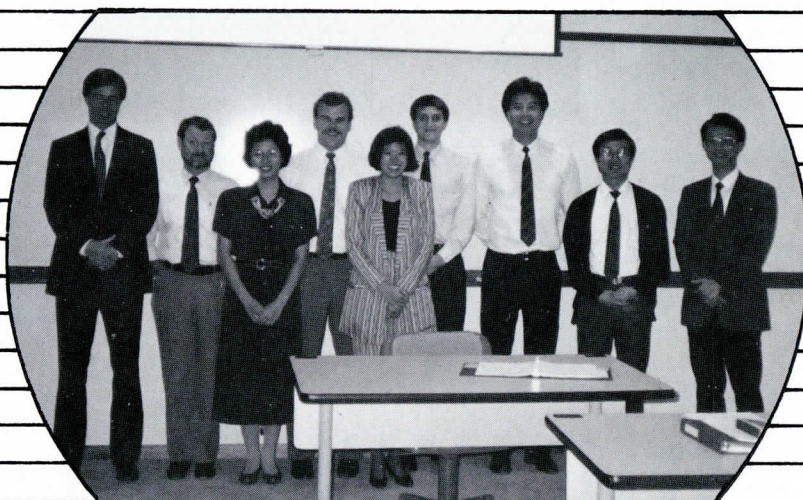


Besides sponsoring our staff for the Malay Mail Big Walk for the past few years, Sungei Way also presented one of the challenge trophies for the annual event.

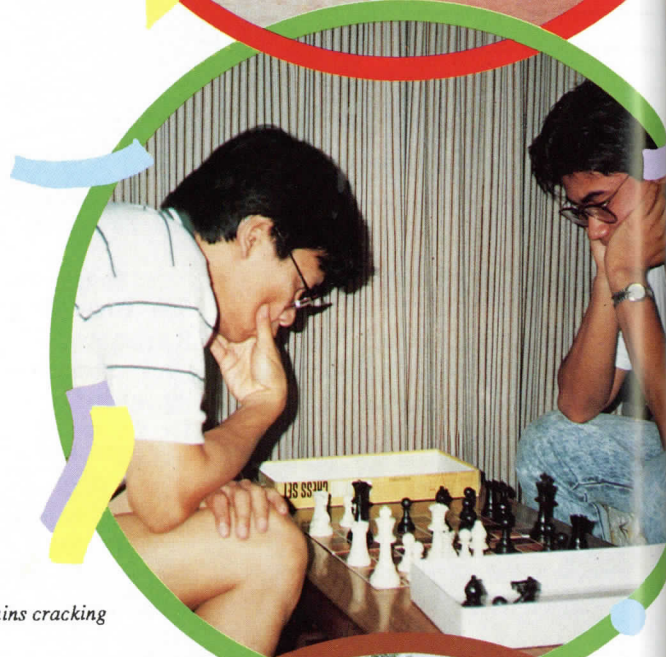
The two days scheduled for this Carnival was stretched to two more weekends, lined with bowling and badminton. Participants played tirelessly and no party was willing to give up.

Sunway College will soon be standing on a 20 acre land in Bandar Sunway. The college to be built in two phases, will on completion, consist of two main blocks, a hostel and a football field. It will be ideally located on the edge of a big blue lake amidst a panoramic waterfall with the proposed Industrial Park on one side and magnificent condominiums on the other.

Work on the first phase, which is estimated to cost about 22 million, is expected to begin soon. The earth breaking ceremony will be held sometime in October this year.

Block One, which consists of classrooms, laboratories, staff rooms, seven lecture halls, a library and an office block, is expected to be ready by June 1990. The proposed hostel which should accommodate a thousand students may also be ready along with Block One.

Work on the second phase will begin in 1992 and would be identical in structure to Block One. Together, the two blocks would be able to accommodate about 10,000 students by the time to come. Sunway College will stand majestically in Beautiful Bandar Sunway as the pride of Sungei Way.



THE LATE TUN HUSSEIN ONN

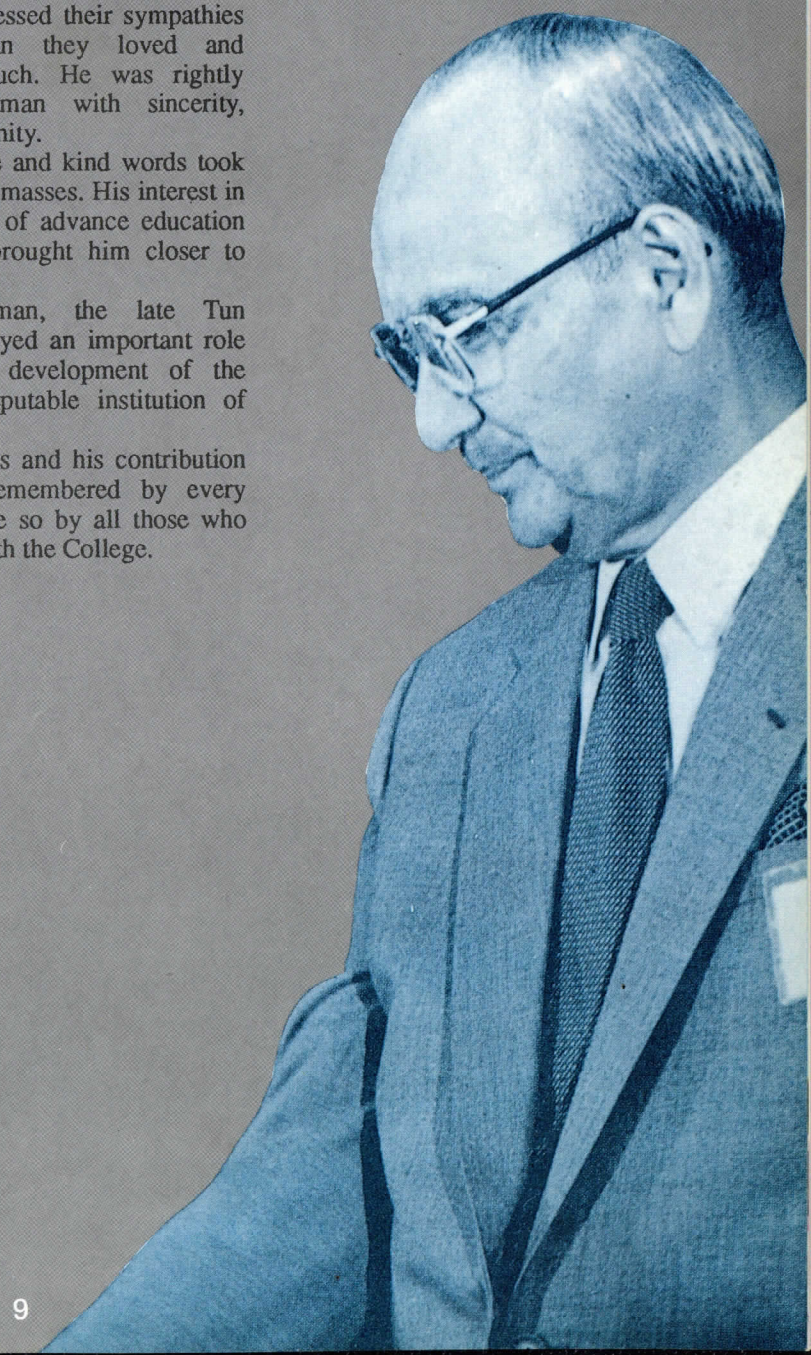
The news of the death of Tun Hussein Onn was received with shock and grief by all Malaysians.

Many expressed their sympathies for a statesman they loved and respected so much. He was rightly praised as a man with sincerity, integrity and dignity.

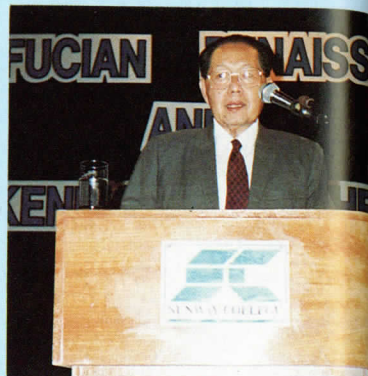
His humble and kind words took him closer to the masses. His interest in the development of advance education in his country brought him closer to Sunway College.

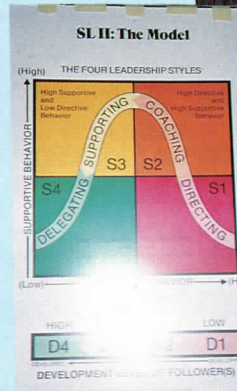

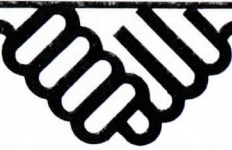


WHIZZ FINGERS.....
