

The 15th SEA Games saw Sungei Wayans and Sunway College students involved in selling tickets and organising the event.




The two days scheduled for this Carnival was stretched to two more weekends, lined with bowling and badminton. Participants played tirelessly and no party was willing to give up.


The highlight of the event was a show performed by Heirborne with Broadway music and dances and the spice of the night was the interesting games that made everyone laugh their hearts out.

As Chairman, the late Tun Hussein Onn played an important role in the gradual development of the College to a reputable institution of higher learning.


