# 100% SUCCESS

All of the first group of students to go from Sunway College in Petaling Jaya, Malaysia to the Law Faculty at the University of Leicester have just graduated with an LLB with honours. In 1987, 35 students actually enrolled at Sunway College.

Five out of a total of 32 students obtained an upper second class degree and one, Jayakumar Nayar, received a first class degree. Mr Nayar was also awarded the May Fund prize for the best student dissertation and the Law Department Prize for the outstanding Part II performance.

In the second year, 42 Sunway students also performed very well in Leicester Law Faculty exams with a Sunway student, Ooi Huey Ling, winning the Maxell Prize for the best performance in Part I exams and the Cole and Cole Prize for the best performance in Land Law. Ms Ooi adds these prizes to the Toller Hales and the Collcutt Prize for Tort and the Law Faculty Prize for the best first year performance.

First year Sunway students, of which there are 47, also produced excellent performances in exams.

The innovative Sunway/Leicester venture involves students taking the first year of their LLB degree at Sunway College in Malaysia, following exactly the same courses as their contemporaries in Leicester Law Faculty. Lecture outlines and course materials prepared for the courses at Leicester are sent to Sunway and Leicester lecturers visit Sunway on a regular basis. Exams are set and marked in Leicester. Sunway

students then go on in the second and third years to Leicester, integrating with students who began their first year in Leicester, and completing their LLB studies in the usual way. Students can also follow the Sunway College route to degrees at Leicester in Economics and Engineering; the first students from Sunway to graduate in these subjects will take their finals next year.

The Law Faculty at Leicester feels that the exam performance of this first cohort of students is one indication of the success of this scheme.

# Selangor Education Department – Sunway College Inaugural Form 6 Inter School English Debate, 1990.

The Selangor Education Department and Sunway College Sdn Bhd together organised the Form 6 Inter – School English Debate between July 16 to September 3, 1990. Sunway College, a leader in twinning education, and a member of the SungeiWay Group, was allocated a sum of ten thousand dollars for the debate.

The final was held at Sunway College on September 3rd, 1990. Sekolah Menengah Kepong won the debate and a prize money of \$1,500.00. The runner-up was Sekolah Menengah (P) Sri Aman of Petaling Jaya. The topic "Higher Education in Malaysia fully prepares us for Adult Life" was well – debated and participants enjoyed listening to both sides.

A total of 21 schools throughout Selangor's eight districts participated in the inaugural debate which was organised for the purpose of promoting the usage of English among secondary school students, especially among students of Lower and Upper Six classes and giving an opportunity to secondary students to practise their verbal skills in English.

The Royal Malaysian Police Body Building Team (RMPBBT) was formed in early 1988 and has its training centre at the Federal Police HQ, Bukit Aman.

The team, comprising 8 pionner body builders, posses great potential to capture titles both at the national and international levels.

SungeiWay Group of companies being the main sponsor has presented a cheque of \$10,000 to be RMPBBT recently.



- 4) Encouraging extracurricular activities among students.





On 8th September 1990, a kaleidoscope of red, black & white unfolded at Puteri Hall, Subang Parade.



## **Furukawa** Hydraulic Crawler Drill


