He is quoted as saying that "no investment is too big when it comes to educating our children who will one day be the leaders and entrepreneurs of our nation", during the official ground-breaking ceremony of Sunway College on March 9, at Bandar Sunway.

The ground-breaking ceremony of the new campus was performed by YB Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim the Minister of Education. Among the distinguished guests were Malaysia's special envoy to the United Nations who is also the Chairman of Sunway College, Datuk Musa Hitam and Menteri Besar of Selangor Tan Sri Dato' Haji Muhammad bin Haji Muhammad Taib.

Earthworks and piling for the new campus has already underway on the 24 acres of land overlooking a magnificent lake. The first phase which has a built-up area of 180,000 square feet is due to be completed in 1992. It will consist of a five-storey academic block equipped with lecture halls, theatres, libraries and drawing and technical rooms.

The whole outlook of the new Sunway College will be complete with the building of the 780,000 square

feet of the second phase which has a 13-storey hostel and an additional academic block which include lecture halls, theatres, laboratories and libraries.

The new campus will be able to accommodate 8,000 full-time students upon completion and enrolment is expected to commence in late 1992.

The prestigious award also gives Devabalan the opportunity to further his studies in International Business at WMU. He also qualified for the university's \$20,000 scholarship.


Devabalan was one of the six candidates selected to present a working paper at the Annual Conference on Undergraduate Research in Pasadena, California last year.


Undergraduate Goh Doh Kit was awarded a scholarship for \$2,055. He was one of the three recipients of WMU's annual awards.

Yang Berbahagia Dato' Jeffrey Cheah was given the honour to present prizes to all the winners in the various games played during last year's Sports Carnival.


To show appreciation towards the out-going committee and to welcome the in-coming ones, fellow staff were treated to a sumptuous buffet dinner after the election.



Good evening and welcome to the SungeiWay Group annual dinner and dance.

We are very honoured indeed to have with us three ministers and many other distinguished guests to grace our function.

My colleagues and I wish to extend to all of you our deep appreciation for your presence here tonight to join us in celebrating this annual event of our Group.

1990 was a very rewarding year for SungeiWay. The conducive economic climate in this region, especially Malaysia contributed much to another year of record profits for us.

Our three VIP guests have contributed much to the growth of our nation and it has been partly through their enlightened leadership, guidance and dedication that Malaysia has prospered.

Our economy continues to grow from strength to strength and confidence amongst investors is very high. In 1990 the investment value of proposed manufacturing projects reached a staggering \$49 billion – up more than 50 percent over the \$20.14 billion figure for 1989.

This is an impressive performance by anyone's standards and we at SungeiWay would like to publicly endorse Yang Berhormat Dato' Seri Rafidah's efforts in this direction.

1990 also witnessed the highly successful staging of Visit Malaysia Year. The campaign, to promote tourism in Malaysia, resulted in an Orang Utan called "Wira" enjoying as much publicity as Yang Berhormat Dato' Sabbaruddin Chik and more importantly earned Malaysia about \$4 billion in foreign exchange between January and November.

In this period 6.5 million tourists visited our shores – an increase of more than 58 percent over the 1989's figure of 4.08 million. This great achievement must largely be attributed to the untiring efforts of Yang Berhormat Dato' Sabbaruddin Chik.

But what use is all the wealth in the world if there is no peace and unity. In Malaysia we are fortunate in that we live in peace and harmony as well as enjoy a relatively high standard of living. Yet we must work harder at being a united force of citizens if our nation is to continue its rapid development.

By creating a new ministry for National Unity and Community Development under the care of Yang Berhormat Dato' Napsiah, the government has accorded top priority to the building of solid and caring citizens to spur the nation to even greater success.

Yang Berhormat Dato' Napsiah as we know was the Minister for Public Enterprises where she has done much to rationalise and systemise the entrepreneurial activities of the Government. We at SungeiWay wish her well in her new and challenging post and offer our support for her efforts in strengthening our community.

Yang Berhormat Dato' Seri Rafidah, Yang Berhormat Dato' Sabbaruddin and Yang Berhormat Dato' Napsiah – the SungeiWay Group is indeed very proud and honoured that you are here sharing tonight with us We assure you of our support in your endeavours to continue the successful development of Malaysia.

Coming back to SungeiWay, as our Group is very diversified, I will not attempt to mention the performance of each and every company. Suffice to say that the results of all companies were most inspiring. This augurs well for the Group taking into account our financial setbacks during the recession.

Since a substantial portion of our operations are concentrated in the construction and building material sector, we have benefitted immensely from the activities generated by the private as well as the public sector. Where necessary, we have expanded our production capacities and this included a new quarry in Penanti, Penang as well as a new plant in Johor Bahru.

On the strength of our operational facilities and capabilities which are strategically located, we are well poised to meet the demands that are expected this year.

On the property front, 1990 was a very active year for the industry as a whole. All launches by Bandar Sunway were successful resulting in the sales of more than 400 units of single and double storey houses, industrial shoplots and double storey shophouses.

For 1991, Bandar Sunway plan to launch approximately 1,800 units of industrial shoplots, condominiums, shophouses, residential houses and flats. I am confident these will be well received based on our track records.

The construction of our new College campus at Bandar Sunway is on schedule. Yang Berhormat Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim has accepted our invitation to perform the groundbreaking ceremony on 4th March.

The first phase of the project will enable us to increase our student population from the present level of more than 1,700 to approximately 3,500. The demand is there and I am confident that, in the not too distant future, we will have to commence the second phase of the College expansion programme so as to accommodate further intakes.

Aside from Petaling Jaya, we are also investigating the possibility of starting a campus in Johor Bahru.

One of the major corporate events last year was the revitalisation of the claypipe project which was shelved four years ago due to recession. Late last year, we signed a new jointventure agreement with Keramo of Belgium to manufacture Keramo pipes. This will be the biggest vitrified claypipe plant in South East Asia.

The plant, costing \$35 million, will be located in the Klang Valley with a capacity of 40,000 tonnes annually. Production is expected to commence in 1992 with some 30% to 40% for exports. The plant will employ more than 200 people.

We have made further progress in our plans to expand overseas. As of now, we have operations in Australia, Indonesia, Thailand and Brunei.

Our interest in Australia includes a horticultural company in Darwin which is the leading supplier of fertilizer and garden products in the northern territory of Australia. We have also concluded an arrangement to acquire a construction company in Brunei.

Even though we have done well in our expansion plan overseas, there is much more to be achieved to firmly establish our Group throughout the Asean region including Australia and New Zealand.

Work on our new Headquarters situated on a 6-acre site at Bandar Sunway is expected to commence in the middle of this year. It will comprise an 18-storey tower block surrounded by three lower office blocks of six storey each and an auditorium. The first phase of the project is scheduled for completion mid 1993.

Ladies and gentlemen, this year we will commence the development of Bandar Sunway Town Centre which covers an area of approximately 175 acres. We have engaged a leading firm of master planners from Hawaii to advise us on this very important project which will include our Group Corporate Headquarters and new College campus.

Also included will be a 500room 4-star resort hotel, a Theme Park, amphitheater, amusement lake, shops, commercial centre and service apartments. The centre of the development will be a big clear lake of 17 acres surrounded by 20 acres of lush landscaping and greenery with natural limestones outcrops and waterfalls.

The whole development, when completed in about five to six years time, will cost approximately \$800 million.

The Group has come a long way since the last recession. All our companies are now operating from solid and sound financial base. Our success is due largely to the dedication, diligence and commitment of our employees. I thank them for their contributions and loyalty.
