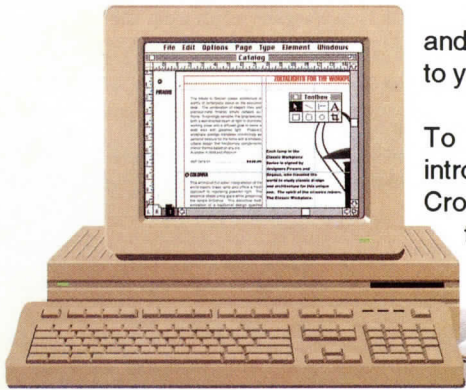

## SPEECH BY GROUP MANAGING DIRECTOR

Honoured guests, my fellow colleagues, ladies and gentlemen.

Good evening and a very warm welcome to the SungeiWay Group Annual Dinner & Dance.

We are very honoured to have with us tonight, our Minister of Primary Industries, Yang Berhormat Dato' Seri Lim Keng Yaik and other distinguished guests to grace our function.

My colleagues and I wish to extend to all of you, our deepest appreciation for your presence here tonight, to join us in celebrating this annual function of our Group.

Ladies and gentlemen

I am pleased to announce that 1992 has been another record year for the Group in terms of growth and profitability. This is a befitting reward for the tremendous efforts contributed by every member of the Group.

Whilst the Malaysian economy, after four successful years of strong growth is expected to moderate in 1993, I am nonetheless confident that we are capable of improving on last year's performance. The turnover for the Group in 1992 was approximately one billion ringgits.

Even though trading conditions and competitions will become more difficult this year, I am confident we can further excel.

At this junction, I would like to share with you some of the many highlights achieved by the Group during 1992 :

\* Our venture into the leisure and entertainment industry was successfully launched when the Sunway Lagoon Waterpark was opened to the public on 24 October last year.

Shortly just before dinner, there will be a video presentation of the facilities available at the Waterpark. Visitors to date have been overwhelming. We are encouraged by the response and at this stage, we are planning Phase 2 expansion to commence some time in the middle of this year.

Amongst the attraction will be the longest suspension walk bridge in the world spanning some 1300 feet across the lake. It will be 8 storey high.

\* In response to the Government's call for more 3 star

hotels, our first venture has commenced in Penang. The 271 rooms 3-star hotel located at New Lane Off Jalan MacAlister is expected to be completed mid 1994 in time to take advantage of the Visit Malaysia Year.

\* Following our tremendous success with the development of Bandar Sunway, the Penang Development Corporation has privatised a \$500 million integrated township to Bandar Sunway.

This is the Bandar Seberang Jaya Township situated on the main land Penang. Construction commenced on November of last year and the entire project is expected to be completed over a period of 8 years.

\* The new college campus for Sunway College was completed on schedule late last year together with the apartment-style hostel which can accommodate 900 students. Sunway College started operation from its new campus on the 4th of the month.

The academic block can accommodate up to 4,500 students. Equipped with the finest academic facilities, the campus has also provided for the use of students, soccer field, badminton, netball and tennis courts.

As I have stated many times before, Sunway College is not profit motivated. Whilst profit is necessary to sustain growth and to maintain operation, the objective

is the provision of best value for money education to Malaysians.

At an appropriate time, it is my commitment to set up a foundation as the beneficiary of the college so as to ensure the perpetuation of Sunway College as a public institution of higher education.

\* Construction on the Group Headquarters has commenced and is expected to be ready for occupation before the end of this year.

\* Sun-Mix Concrete is the first ready-mixed manufacturer in this country to receive the prestigious international ISO 9002 Award from SIRIM. It is also the first company in Malaysia to have its laboratories accredited by Sistem Akreditasi Malaysia of SIRIM. This accreditation enables Sun-Mix to conduct testing for other companies in the same industry.

\* Sunway PMI Pile launches its latest 125mm x 125mm piles. This product is the result of intensive R&D to further boost the performance and to enhance the applications of the hydraulic

injection system. The revolutionary piling system contributes to a cleaner and healthier environment as it is noiseless, vibration and pollution free.

\* The factory for Sunway Keramo, the \$40 million dollars joint venture between SungeiWay and Keramo of Belgium, was completed last year. It will commence production this month.

As the Group continues to expand, the need to retain and to attract the right calibre of employees becomes all the more critical. Human resources have been and will also remain our single most valuable asset. We have spared no efforts to provide training to our employees in the past and this will have to be intensified in order to provide us with the leading edge in the years to come.

Apart from external training, we have the distinct advantage of the enormous resources of Sunway College which will be at our entire disposal. We must exploit this advantage to the fullest for the benefit of our employees so as to be able to continue to sustain the

growth that we have seen over the last few years.

As we strive together in the new year to attain far better results than we have seen before, the emphasis must be on team work. Our theme for last year which is 'We Strive Together' is to my mind most appropriate for the task ahead of us. We should maintain this theme for this year.

When we move to our new Headquarters building towards the end of this year, I am sure the physical closeness will further foster greater team spirit. In this manner, we will become more united in our strives to attain our business objectives.

The spin-off resulting from operations under one roof will in the long run result in lasting benefits for the Group. Apart from ease of communication, the fact that the building will incorporate certain aspects of appropriate intelligence. I am sure it will contribute towards greater effectiveness and productivity.

Tonight, we will be presenting long service award to 30 of our employees who have served the Group for more than 10 years. This presentation of award has become a tradition. Each year, it is most gratifying to note the increasing numbers of our employees attaining 10 years services record with the Group. As mentioned in my speech last year, we will be making presentation tonight for the Best Business Plan Award for this year. Planning is an essential ingredient for business success. In SungeiWay, we believe in and are totally committed to planning.

The introduction of the award for business plan is consequently a logical move to encourage our



managers to place greater emphasis in the preparation of their Business Plans. We will announce the winners for this award later this evening.

I view with confidence the ability of the Group to perform well in 1993. I believe we have, within our means, the ingredients for success. We will have quarries located in all the strategic locations in mid 1993. This will place our Quarry division in a commanding position to exploit the opportunities that are expected to be generated not only from infra-structure development but also the proposed international airport at Sepang as well as for the 1998 Commonwealth Games.

Our Construction Division has also attained maturity and is now a major player in the industry capable of undertaking multi-million dollar projects.

The further intensification of development activities at Bandar

Sunway will generate considerable interests and business activities for the Group. Apart from the second hotel at Sunway Lagoon Resort, the commercial centre cum shopping mall is also scheduled for commencement.

This commercial centre cum shopping mall will have a capacity of 1.2 million square feet of lettable space. For 1993, we intend to initiate the first phase of approximately 400,000 square feet which will also incorporate the only ice skating rink in this country.

Ladies and gentlemen, I would like to take the opportunity to record my appreciation and to acknowledge the achievements of our dedicated and loyal employees. Our People is Our Strength. What we are today is the result of your efforts. I am confident I can count on your continued support and contribution in the years to come.

## EXCELLENT YEAR FOR SUNGEIWAY

This was achieved on the back of RM316.5 million turnover, which rose by 36% from 233.3 million previously.

The impressive performance was due to higher operating margins which was a result of the buoyant construction sector as well as the Group's high productivity, cost efficiency and quality control programmes.

The Groups' construction division currently has an order book of about RM 650 million spread between infrastructure (70%) and housing works (30%). The orders on hand are expected to keep the Group busy for the next two to three years.

SungeiWay is currently one of the largest and most efficient quarry operators in the country, with quarries situated in strategic locations throughout the country. In tandem with the rapid infrastructural growth in the country, SungeiWay acquired two more quarries in 1992, one in Kuantan, Pahang and another in Kulai, Johor. In March 1993, a quarry in Nilai was acquired. This quarry is located close to the proposed Sepang International Airport and is expected to commence

operation in the early part of 1994. The Group also recently expanded the production capacity of a few existing quarries, and is presently finalizing the acquisition of new quarries to broaden its quarry reserve in the country.

In 1992, the ready-mixed division remained as the market and price leader with a production capacity of 65,000 cubic metres per month. As a result of the company's high commitment to quality, it was recently accredited with the ISO 9002 by SIRIM, making it the first ready-mixed company in Malaysia to receive this award.

Sunway Keramo Sdn. Bhd., a joint-venture company formed with S.A. Keramo of Belgium, commenced its vitrified claypipes operations in February 1993. The initial production capacity for the plant is 24,000 tonnes per month and this may be doubled in the future when the demand rises.

The company is expected to perform better in the current year, given the present favourable market conditions and rapid infrastructural growth in the country.

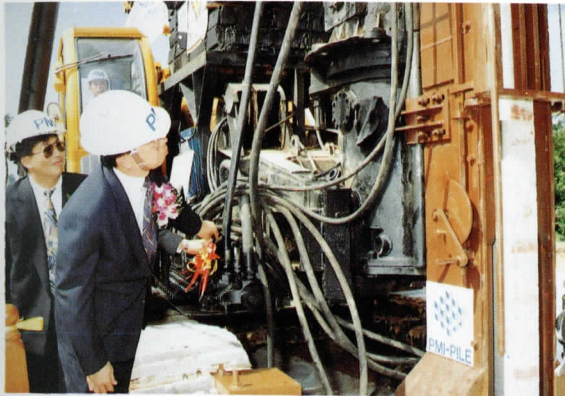
## SUNWAY PMI-PILE LAUNCHES 125 MM X 125 MM PILE

Sunway PMI-Pile Construction Sdn. Bhd. officially launched its 125 mm x 125 mm pile on 4th January 1993 at Universiti Malaya's proposed examination hall site.

The launch was officiated by YB Datuk Law Hieng Ding, the Minister of Science, Technology and Environment. More than 300 guests attended the launch.

This historic moment marked a significant breakthrough for Sunway PMI-Pile in piling technology. Since SungeiWay acquired the PMI-Pile system in 1989, the engineers at Sunway PMI-Pile spared no efforts in improving and establishing the system and developing bigger size piles to cater for heavier loads. At the time of the launch, the 150 mm x 150 mm size pile was already on the drawing board and set for tests in Penang. To date, the company has completed over 200 projects throughout the Peninsula, has served reputed and established developers and is now setting its sights on the international market with its patented piling system.

This is an exciting era for Sunway PMI-Pile as it sets to create an impact in the construction industry and revolutionise the piling industry with its environmental friendly system.

The growing awareness of environmental issues has set the stage for Sunway PMI-Pile to gain strength and mount up its wings in taking off with no hitches. The company has now spread its operations to cover the northern and southern regions with bases in Penang and Johor respectively and before long, will be an international name.

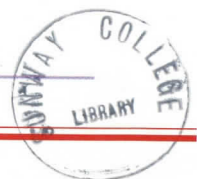

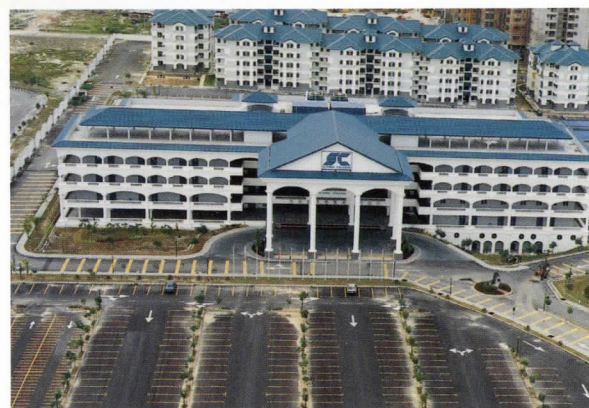

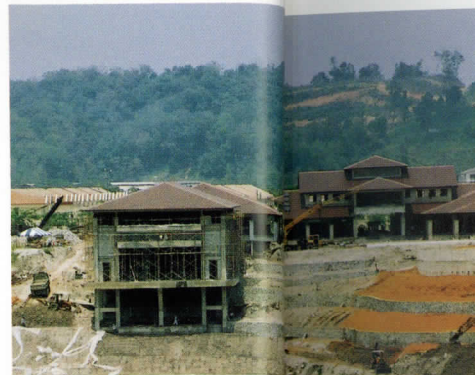

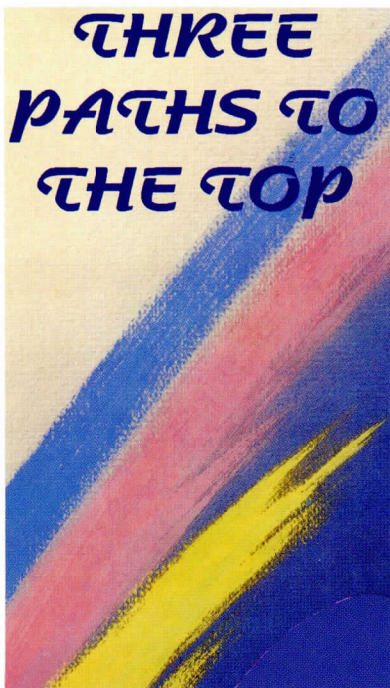


## SUSPENDED BRIDGE

\* It's a lot easier to build a bridge than a career ladder.

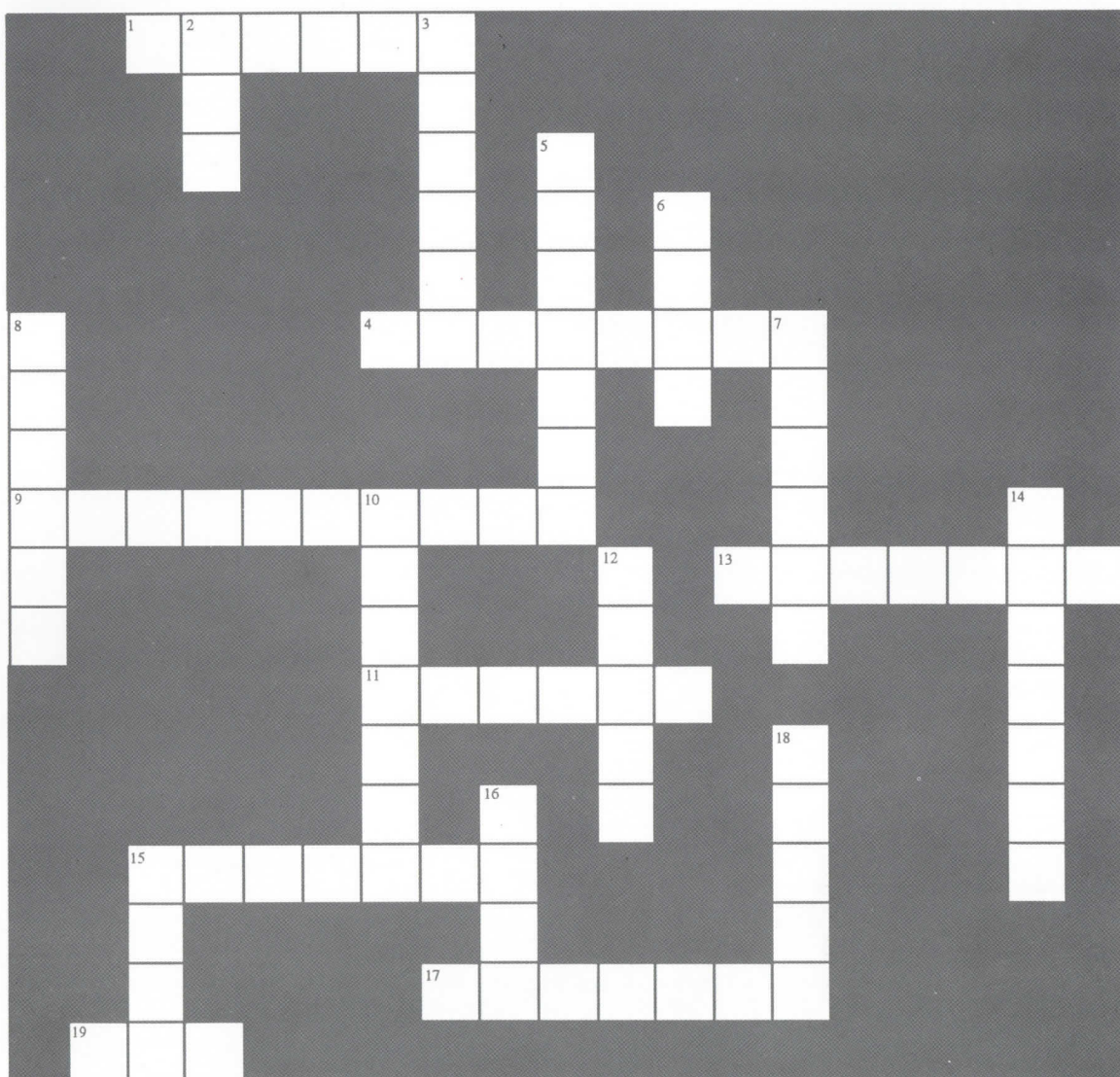

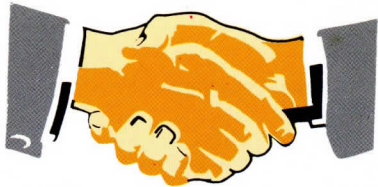
