

A ground-breaking ceremony for Sunway Carnival was officiated by YAB Tan Sri Koh Tsu Koon, Chief Minister of Penang, on 4th January.

Sunway Carnival is a family shopping and entertainment centre covering more than 1 million square feet of total built-up area. Situated at Pusatbandar Bandar Seberang Jaya (PBSJ) on the mainland side of Penang state, it is going to be one of the largest shopping complexes in the northern region of Peninsula Malaysia when completed.

Parkson Corporation will be the

anchor tenant, operating under the name, X'tra Supercentre.

With its fun mall leisure concept, Sunway Carnival also comprises a 36-lane bowling alley, a food court, an amusement park, a 5-screen cineplex, ample parking space, a multi-purpose hall, promotion areas and some 360 retail lots which will provide an excellent retail mix.

In his welcoming speech, SungeiWay Group President, Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah said, PBSJ came into being when Sunway City Berhad formed a partnership with the Penang Development Corporation (PDC) to develop the RM1 billion integrated commercial centre which would function as the new commercial hub of the northern region of Peninsula Malaysia.

Among dignitaries who were present to grace the occasion were YB Dato' Kee Phaik Cheen, Penang State Executive Councillor for Tourism, Culture, the Arts and Women's Development and Encik Roslan bin Ibrahim, the Deputy General Manager of PDC.

The RM1.0 million prize money makes it the most lucrative prize money in the world of cycling held in the most exotic and exciting terrain and environment.



National Kidney Foundation Gets RM408, 000 Boost from the Group

The National Kidney Foundation (NKF) got a "shot in the arm" from the SungeiWay Group which donated a total of RM408,000 to the Foundation for its activities.

SungeiWay Group President, Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Jeffrey Cheah presented a cheque to NKF's Chairman of Board of Governors, Datuk K Pathmanaban during a ceremony held at Sunway Lagoon Resort Hotel.

The NKF also provides on-going training programmes for medical personnel such as nurses, renal technicians and paramedics in the treatment of kidney patients. In addition it organises exhibitions, public seminars and forums throughout the country to increase public awareness and understanding of kidney diseases.
