Sunway University hosted the ASEAN Workshop on Sustainable Development 2025, organised by the United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network (UN-SDSN) Asia headquarters. The event brought together senior Cabinet members, high-level ASEAN delegates, and leading academics to generate impactful policy recommendations, supporting Malaysia's ASEAN chairmanship in 2025.

Sunway University: 7th most sustainable University in Malaysia! 11 December 2024



Sunway University has been ranked as the 7th most sustainable institution in Malaysia, according to the prestigious QS Sustainability Rankings 2025. A total of 29 Malaysian institutions were ranked. In Asia, Sunway University was ranked #97 out of 661 institutions. These rankings aim to evaluate and showcase the social and environmental impact of universities as centres of education and research, while also considering their role as major employers. They consider the operational sustainability challenges that any large and complex organisation, such as a university, must navigate to create a positive impact.

Sunway University: 145th Most Sustainable University Worldwide! 18 December 2024



Sunway University is excited to announce its impressive achievement in the 2024 UI GreenMetric World University Rankings, securing the 145th position globally and ranking as the 9th best university in Malaysia. This achievement marks a significant milestone, as Sunway University has climbed 26 spots from last year's rankings, the largest leap among Malaysian universities. In addition, Sunway University has achieved the top spot (#1) in Malaysia for the transportation category, improving from its #2 ranking last year. The UI GreenMetric rankings, which evaluated 1,477 universities from 95 countries, recognise institutions for their dedication to sustainability and global environmental impact.

The rankings are based on six key categories that assess a university's sustainability efforts across various areas. Below are the rankings for Sunway University in each of these categories:

1. Setting & Infrastructure: #188 globally, #13 in Malaysia

2. Water: #182 globally, #11 in Malaysia

3. Energy & Climate Change: #244 globally, #6 in Malaysia

4. Transportation: #32 globally, #1 in Malaysia

5. Waste: #397 globally, #20 in Malaysia

6. Education & Research: #171 globally, #11 in Malaysia

Empowering the Desa Mentari community through entrepreneurship 03 March 2025



Sunway iLabs spearheads impactful initiatives under the Sunway Desa Mentari Programme, a comprehensive effort by Sunway University to uplift the B40 community residing in Desa Mentari PPPR flats through entrepreneurial empowerment. This programme reflects a collective commitment to fostering positive social impact by leveraging the strengths and expertise of diverse collaborators.

In December, Sunway iLabs at Sunway University conducted the first cohort of the Bengkel Kemahiran dan Motivasi Keusahawanan (BKMK). The workshop brought together nine female microentrepreneurs, aged 27 to 57, from the Desa Mentari community. These micro-entrepreneurs, including home-based F&B sellers and traditional saree makers, participated in a two-day session to acquire essential entrepreneurial skills. Key areas of learning included social media marketing in collaboration with TikTok Shop Malaysia and financial literacy, which covered cost estimation and pricing strategies. The success of the workshop was driven by a collaborative effort involving facilitators and mentors from TikTok Shop Malaysia, Sunway iLabs, the Sunway University Community Development and Engagement team, and Sunway students and alumni. They provided hands-on guidance and personalised support to ensure participants could effectively apply their newfound knowledge.

Beyond the workshop, follow-up plans are in place to offer continued support to ensure sustainable growth for these micro-entrepreneurs. This holistic approach underscores the dedication of all involved in driving long-term impact for the Desa Mentari community.

The BKMK initiative highlights Sunway iLabs' leadership in fostering innovation and addressing real-world challenges. Working in synergy with Sunway University and its extensive ecosystem, this programme demonstrates the transformative power of education and entrepreneurship. By uniting the efforts of multiple stakeholders, Sunway iLabs continues to pave the way for meaningful community development, setting a benchmark for building a more equitable and empowered society.
